



Select the E-Paper icon in the bottom footer navigation and you will be prompted to Log In. Enter subscription credentials and open the E-Paper to read the lastest edition.



**Law turned certain arrests into sentences**

**S**hehien Lippman was in trouble when a Summerville police officer cracked one for his uninvited urban townhouse.

He was in trouble for the blunt 11 grams of cannabis and two grams of marijuana and a black and white Weimaraner in his passenger seat. He was in trouble for the plastic baggies, scale and \$1,000 in cash.

That's mostly, he was in trouble because of the traffic stop.

At the time of the traffic stop, Lippman had just come out of jail for a year since the 2019 crash in which another man was accused of crashing a drive-by shooting in Orangeburg and killing one and wounding two others.

If the stop had been in 2022, Lippman could've likely been fined, or jail time, but in 2023, a new South Carolina law means the police charged with simple crimes who've been bound may face near-impossible bail amounts and wait long wait times before being released.

Lippman couldn't have known that, under the new law, his arrest was sentence in itself, regardless of evidence or the dismissal of charges. He couldn't have known that the new law had turned all the arrests he had been in jail into "dead time" that couldn't be knocked off.

- Select to Refresh icon to start over or "X" to exit.




