
Land Use Analysis

This is a general survey for planning purposes, MDC/CDM Smith does not guarantee the accuracy of this analysis for site specific conditions.




COMMITTED OR ANTICIPATED TO CHANGE?




CURRENT INVENTORY OF HOMES

There is significant land area under development.


Anticipated to yield 6,815 new homes

REMAINING UNCOMMITTED LAND







REMAINING UNCOMMITTED LAND

- There is 1,621 acres of land that does not have an approved plan of development.
- The future land use plan is applied to each area to determine the capacity for development
 - Wetlands and other constrained land is removed
 - Densities are applied based on future land use recommendations and zoning regulations

ESTIMATED TOTAL CAPACITY OF THE TOWN AT BUILDOUT

- Existing~38,000 homes
- Pipeline Capacity
 ~6,800 new homes

PDAs Capacity
 ~5,600 new homes

TOTAL CAPACITY

- 50,400 HOMES
- ~105,000-117,000 PEOPLE
 - 93% Occupancy rate
 - 2.24-2.50 people per household
