Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, Det. W. Crockett who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, Derrick Samuel Stewart Jr did within this county and state on the 30 October 2021 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on October 30 2021 at approximately 1437 hours, while at 1750 Raul Wallenberg Blvd (Pinecrest Apartment) which is in the County and City of Charleston, S.C., the above named defendant, Derrick Samuel Stewart Jr, did knowingly, willingly, and unlawfully violate SC State Statute 16-3-10 (Murder) in the following particulars:

On Saturday, October 30, 2021 at around 1437 hours, CPD Officers responded to 1750 Raul Wallenberg Blvd, (Pinecrest Apartments), Charleston, SC in reference to a shooting that just occurred. Upon arrival Officers located the victim, Travis Terrell Green, Jr in the driver seat of his 2004 Black Jaguar (SC Tag: 9424PD) suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported by Charleston County EMS to MUSC where he was pronounced deceased. This incident is subsequently being investigated as a homicide.

The apartment complex office, which is located across from the incident location, was equipped with surveillance footage capturing the parking lot. This footage revealed two black males walking across the parking lot at around 1424 hours. One black male is wearing a light colored jacket and black pants, while the second suspect is wearing all black. Both parties walk toward the incident location. The victim's vehicle arrives in the complex at around 1434 hours and goes out of camera view. At approximately 1435 hours, a black male wearing all black runs past the office toward 1800 Ashley West Apartments, and is carrying what appears to be a backpack. A few seconds later a black male wearing a blue denim jacket and black pants and appears to be carrying something in his right hand. These suspects appear to be the same individuals captured walking toward the incident location 10 minutes before the murder. Based on this security camera footage, Detectives believe that the suspects fled the area headed west through the yards toward William Kennerty Drive. Detectives subsequently conducted a video canvass of the surrounding area obtaining video footage from 1800 William Kennerty Drive (1800 Ashley West Apartments).

AFFIDAVIT

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During the investigation, CPD Detectives interviewed several of the victim's family members who indicated that the victim was in a monetary dispute with his cousin (later identified as Antonio "AJ" Green Jr and hereafter referred to as the Defendant) over a matter of 75 dollars. The victim's father (Travis Green Sr) stated that the matter was over the mis-handling of narcotics belonging to the Defendant and that the Defendant replied to a Facebook post on October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 that stated, "Niggas will owe you money and move like y'all beefing. Bro just pay me" by posting, "Sushi bitch ass." It should be known that the victim's nickname is "Sushi." The victim's father understood this to be a threat toward the victim over the aforementioned debt.

Detectives located Green's driver's license information via the South Carolina DMV website and observed that he bears similar physical characteristics as the suspect wearing the light-colored jacket in the security camera footage. A further query of the South Carolina DMV system indicated that Green is the registered owner of a 2007 Nissan Altima with a South Carolina license plate of UMK857. The Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) system captured this vehicle entering the West Ashley area at 04:12 hours on the morning of October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021. ALPR photographs reveal that this vehicle is dark grey in color and has rain guards installed over both front and rear side windows.

During a review of the security footage obtained from 1800 William Kennerty Drive, Detectives observed a dark grey Nissan Altima with rain guards turn onto William Kennerty Drive and head toward the incident location at 13:51 hours, approximately 9 minutes before the suspects are observed on the Pinecrest Apartment security cameras. The same Nissan Altima is then observed heading the opposite direction on William Kennerty Drive, away from the incident location, at 14:38 hours, approximately 1 minute after the first 911 call was received.

On 10/31/2021, Antonio Green Jr met with Detectives at CPD Headquarters. During a post Miranda statement, Green advised that on 10/30/2021 he was with Derrick Stewart (the Defendant) and another male (co-defendant) in West Ashley who arranged to meet the victim to purchase marijuana. The Defendant already contacted the victim and arranged to meet at the Pinecrest Apartments. Green advised he and the Defendant met the ~~Sease~~ <sup>Co-defendant</sup> at his house. Green then drove the co-defendants to the neighborhood behind the Pinecrest Apartments and parked his vehicle. They all exited the vehicle and walked to the apartments to wait for the victim. They were hanging out by the stairs when the Defendant received a message from the victim that he was arriving.

Due to the victim and Green having a dispute over the victim owing him money, he knew that the victim would not speak to the co-defendants if the victim saw him. When the victim arrived, Green started to walk behind the building but observed the Defendant enter the front seat of the victim's vehicle while the co-defendant entered the rear passenger seat behind the victim. Within seconds of Green walking behind the building, he heard one gunshot followed by another (2) gunshots. Green immediately fled behind the building toward the entrance, crossed the parking lot and fled toward the vehicle. When he arrived at his vehicle, the Defendant was already waiting for him in the vehicle. When Green and the Defendant arrived back at the co-defendants residence, Green confronted them about what happened. At that time, the Defendant informed Green that when they were trying to purchase marijuana from the victim, he tried to increase the price. The victim went to reach for "something," and the co-defendant subsequently shot him. After shooting the victim, they took a bag containing marijuana from the vehicle and fled the scene. During the interview, Green advised that earlier in the week the Defendant spoke to him about wanting to rob the victim.

Green provided Detectives with the Defendant's Facebook profile name (Lo Hitta) which allowed Detectives to view the Defendant's profile and subsequently identify the Defendant as Derrick Stewart. Detectives requested a SLED generated six-photo lineup which was presented to Green. Green positively identified the Defendant in the six-photo lineup as the individual that actively participated in the robbery and was in the vehicle at the time of the shooting. Further review of the video surveillance yielded footage of the subject identified as Stewart fleeing the area with a pink backpack determined to belong to the victim.

Based on the surveillance footage obtained from the Pinecrest Apartments, the footage obtained from 1800 Ashley West Apartments, the statements provided by the victim's family members, the statement provided by Antonio Green J, that he drove the Defendant to meet the victim, at which time the victim was murdered and Green positively identifying the Defendant via a six photo lineup, this affiant believes probable cause is established to charge the defendant, Derrick Samuel Stewart Jr, with a violation of South Carolina Statute 16-3-10 Murder, for killing the victim, Travis Terrell Green Jr, with malice aforethought.

The above is true and believable based on the statements of Antonio Green, the video surveillance, the positive identification of the defendant, and the investigation conducted by Detectives with the Charleston Police Department.

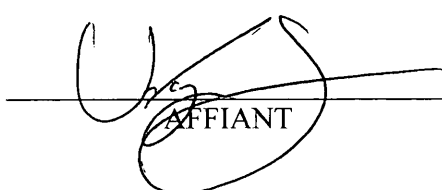
