**DELEGATE MOYLAN ANNOUNCES DATES AND LOCATION FOR SECTION 504  
SCREENING AND INTAKE**

(Hagatña, Guam). The Office of Delegate James Moylan, along with the Guam State Office of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) are inviting qualified senior citizens to the following locations on the respective dates for the USDA Section 504 Program screening and intake:

**NORTHERN RESIDENTS**

Monday, May 6, 2024, 2pm to 6pm  
Dededo Senior Center

**SOUTHERN RESIDENTS**

Tuesday, May 7, 2pm to 6pm  
Hagat Senior Center

**CENTRAL RESIDENTS**

Thursday, May 9, 2024, 6pm to 8pm  
MTM Community Center

The USDA Section 504 Program provides seniors who are at least 62 years of age with a total household income level which does not exceed \$40,400 (for a household of four, and additional tiers also exist), loans and/or grants for home repairs or improvements. Grants may be up to \$10,000 and low-interest loans are up to \$40,000. The loan interest rates are 1% and terms are up to 20 years. The grants may be utilized to remove health and safety hazards around one's home.

*"We are excited to get the process rolling on the Section 504 program and thank USDA for their support in educating qualified residents, along with the application intake. I also would like to thank Mayor's Melissa Savares (Dededo), Kevin Susuico (Hagåt), and Rudy Paco (MTM) and their staff for providing the venue and support for this process. I also would like to thank other Mayors for reaching out to qualified residents in their villages and inviting them",* stated Delegate Moylan. *"This program will certainly assist many manåmko' with needed home repairs, while circulating additional federal funds within the island. Based on the outcome next week, I am certain that additional sessions for (application) intake may be scheduled for future weeks",* added Delegate Moylan.

USDA officials will be present to screen applicants for income qualification and will intake information. Interested individuals should bring check stubs or any documents noting income for all those residing in their dwelling and a debt schedule of monthly payments.
