Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Debt payments for this period disclosed on Schedule D do not equal the payments itemized on Schedule B. Each expenditure to a person, which in the aggregate exceeds \$200 for the election cycle, must be reported on Schedule B including the name and address of the payee on Schedule D. "Person" includes an individual, partnership, corporation, association, and public or private organization -- other than an agency of the United States Government. Additionally, the date, amount and purpose of the original purchase must be provided.

Out-of-pocket spending by candidates, as agents of their authorized committees, requires memo entry itemization of the ultimate vendor if the aggregate amount of payments to that vendor exceeds \$200 for the election cycle. The memo entry must include the date, amount, and purpose of the out-of-pocket payments, as well as the name and address of the vendor to which payment was made. Please amend your report to correct the discrepancies in the payments reported on Schedule D as made to Michael F.Q. San Nicolas and Thomas Calvo, Jr. (11 CFR §§ 104.3(b)(4)(i) and 100.10)

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an



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enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
