We have now completed our search for, compilation and review of records responsive to your records request for:

"Any investigative documents, police reports or other documents related to a sexual assault/rape complaint by Adriane Jennings against a police officer, filed in March 2014, or March 2015."

Please be advised that pursuant to:

5 GCA § 10108. Limitation on Right of Inspection.

Except as provided in § 10109 of this Chapter, nothing in this Chapter shall be construed to require disclosure of records that are any of the following:

(n) For the Guam Police Department: investigatory records compiled for law enforcement purposes, but only to the extent that the production of such records would:

- (1) interfere with enforcement proceedings;
- (2) deprive a person of a right to a fair trial or an impartial adjudication;
- (3) constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy;
