Dear Mr. Attorney General:

It has come to my attention from the Director of Public Health and Social Services that your office has advised her that the importation and presence of CBD products is currently illegal and therefore can neither be imported nor sold on Guam. Additionally, the Director of Guam Customs and Quarantine is following suit with respect to not allowing CBD products to be imported into Guam.

Congressman Mike San Nicolas has also written to both aforementioned directors citing concerns that the actions taken by them individually, is unwarranted and could violate issues of civil rights; a copy of his letter is attached for your review.

Given that our local agencies are acting under some initial guidance from your office, I am respectfully requesting for you to make a written determination of your position on the ability of local businesses and individuals to import CBD products to Guam. Given the tremendous interest in having these products available, your urgent reply is appreciated.
