DRT Announces Moratorium for Affected Taxpayers and Consumers

April 01, 2026 – Barrigada, Guam - The Department of Revenue and Taxation (DRT) acknowledges the challenges many taxpayers and consumers are currently facing due to its ongoing limited operations. In light of these challenges, DRT will be implementing a moratorium for those affected.

The moratorium will include waiving certain penalties and fees and extending certain services for individuals impacted. Further information on the specifics of these waivers and extensions will be forthcoming. The department will provide details of this moratorium once it is satisfied that it effectively addresses the needs of all affected taxpayers and consumers.

While DRT looks forward to resuming full operational capacity as quickly as possible, the following services and transactions remain available:

- Filing tax returns manually and making payments if owed
- Vehicle registration and renewal
- Payment accepted for all types of taxes, including Business Privilege Tax, Income Tax, and Real Property Tax
- U.S. Passport Services
- Compliance Branch and the Insurance, Securities, Banking and Real Estate Branch services and transactions
