



Release from “#5 (Incumbent), Toughest AG on Crime”: AG Moylan “Passes” on GBA’s Debate for GBA Leaders’ Bias & Financial Interests.

(Monday, September 14, 2026)

What do you call 100 lawyers at the bottom of the sea? A good start.

A fundamental requirement in any debate is that the moderators be “***fair & impartial.***” Unfortunately, for the past 4 years, certain controlling leaders of the Guam Bar Association (“GBA”) hijacked my own professional association and tried to remove me from important criminal cases in my duty to protect our People, mischaracterized the truth, and actively tried to unseat me as the People’s Democratically-Elected Attorney General. After a careful review of the GBA President’s invitation for an “Attorney General debate,” my campaign team and I elect to “***pass.***” We, however, confirmed attendance to participate in multiple other forums where we believe their moderators will be “***fair & impartial.***”

We believe bias exists in the “GBA”: (i) earlier released a “survey” of its members purporting to be the GBA’s memberships’ position, yet it reflected a minority of the members, (ii) the GBA President on several occasions (unsuccessfully) tried to have me personally sanctioned on her and her clients’ behalf, thereby maintaining a *disqualifiable personal & financial conflict of interest* for which she should have properly removed herself from hosting this debate; (iii) this GBA Pres., and at least 1 other GBA leader, is in active criminal and civil litigations against my client (People of Guam / Govt. of Guam) representing many clients against us, for which these GBA leaders have a ***financial interest*** in having me removed as the sitting Attorney General over their clients (esp. criminal) cases, yet these persons failed to disqualify themselves from involvement in this debate, as a Judge or Justice would normally do; and (iv) apparently, the GBA leadership shockingly seek the elimination of Guam’s Attorney General being democratically-elected by our People, so the position can once again be controlled by the Governor. Why even conduct an “AG Debate” if you don’t believe in democracy? The GBA should host a Gubernatorial debate.

I refuse to be “***ambushed***” by a ***biased*** moderating forum with ***financial conflicts of interest*** and an “***axe to grind***” against me for doing my job for our People (my client). “*I’d rather spend this time working with my team winning criminal trials to keep our People SAFE.*” This 2-Term Attorney General, seeking a 3rd term, is the only experienced Attorney General, who after 4 years managing Guam’s largest law office, has now secured **93 criminal jury trial wins, 875+ criminal convictions by plea and 115 criminal aliens deported** (or in process) as of today . . . and counting. I look forward to participating in the upcoming forums where we can fairly discuss the legal issues, and I will show what ~35 years of legal practice on Guam gives to our voters over that of the other 4 AG candidates.

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
