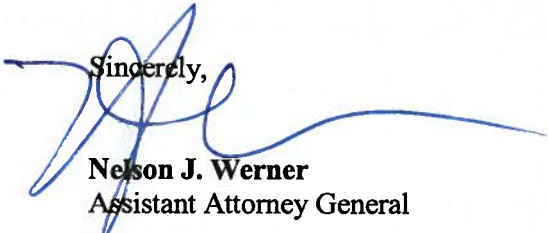

As part of our ongoing criminal investigation, we have requested and reviewed documents related to the cases above, including all documents served upon the employees along with their adverse actions. As we continue to investigate this matter, we anticipate that many more individuals may be questioned and investigated for potential criminal activity and prosecution.

Therefore, we respectfully request that the Civil Service Commission refrain from compelling parties to disclose documents produced in response to our inquiry into these sensitive matters. We thank you for your attention and professional courtesy.
