CLOSURE OF GSWA FACILITIES AND RESIDENTIAL TRASH COLLECTION DUE TO TROPICAL STORM SINLAKU

(Guam, April 10, 2026) – The Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) today announced operational changes due to the approaching Tropical Storm Sinlaku.

In response to the approaching Tropical Storm Sinlaku and in reference to the Joint Information Center Release No. 1 dated April 10, 2026, GSWA has temporarily adjusted its operations as follows:

GSWA Facilities:

- Residential Transfer Stations, Layon Landfill and the Hauler Only Transfer Station will be open for normal business hours tomorrow, Saturday, April 11, 2026. The Hauler Only Transfer Station will extend its operations by one hour, and remain open from 4:30am – 1pm. Layon Landfill will remain open from 7am – 3:30pm.
- GSWA facilities will be closed and trash collection services will be temporarily suspended effective Sunday, April 12, 2026 through Tuesday, April 14, 2026 until otherwise announced by GSWA.

Customers are strongly advised to secure their trash and recycle carts properly to prevent any potential hazards or loss during adverse weather conditions. Once Guam is placed back in Condition of Readiness 4 and it is deemed safe to do so, GSWA facilities will reopen, and trash collection services will resume. GSWA thanks our customers for their understanding and cooperation.
