In response to the recent press release made by the Speaker, I would like to formally let it be known that no obstruction of transparency has occurred. In the recent passing of Bill 12-37 my colleagues and I were all in agreement with how the bill would come forth once passed and signed, having all leases go through legislation.

Yesterday afternoon was not a partisan or unilateral group meeting as myself, Senator Roy Quinata, Senator William Parkinson, Senator Joe San Augustin, and Senator Frank Blas Jr., who is the minority leader of the Republican party, were all in attendance.

With the new hospital and having a missile-defense adjacent to it, I am always up for the discussion and matters to help the people of Guam, **always**. I have no political gain towards any matters put into legislation, nor any hopes for personal access or gain towards any type of government decision. I am transparent myself and any office or community member is welcomed to visit me, to sit down and discuss any matters they would like addressed or to be heard.

I am in agreement with Senator Parkinson's statement that he is **not okay** with 12-37 meaning we would lose the new hospital and cause original landowners to not get their land back.

The speaker referring to the Governor of Guam as the "Naval Governor" is a political attack, and the Honorable Governor did not overstep her power as Bill 12-37 has not gone through all channels after voting between my colleagues and I, and is not officially passed into law.

I am always honest and will always give first support to my colleagues and the leaders of our Island should decisions be made best for the people of Guam.
