### Press Release

Today I have filed suit against Mr. Douglas Moylan in the Superior Court of Guam. I have done so to stop Mr. Moylan's illegal expenditure of taxpayer money by erecting billboards in support of and in respect to a religious belief.


The Constitution of the United States of America commands that "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof . . ." *U.S. Const., amend I.*

The Organic Act of Guam is equally forceful, "No public money or property shall ever be appropriated, supplied, donated, or used, directly or indirectly, for the use, benefit, or support of any sect, church, denomination, sectarian institution, or association, or system of religion, or for the use, benefit, or support of any priest, preacher, minister, or other religious teacher or dignitary as such." *48 U.S.C. §1421(b)(p).*

Defendant Moylan's billboards, which we pay for, promote a Judeo-Christian religious orthodoxy without any secular context. Rather they proselytize religious dogma which is familiar to Mr. Moylan but foreign to the laws of Guam and the United States.

As an attorney, I have sworn "[T]hat I will support The Constitution of the United States, The Organic Act of Guam, the applicable statutes of the United States and the laws of Guam . . ." I made that same promise when I accepted a commission in the United States Navy and when I was seated in the Guam Legislature. Promises are meant to be kept and I will do so.

For these reasons I sue Mr. Moylan to stop his illegal actions and recover money for the People of Guam. God Bless the Constitution. God Bless Guam.
