Subject: Request for meeting and visitation/tour of DOC, Mangilao

Buenas yan Hafa Adai General Moylan! I was notified that the meeting I requested in reference to a communications memo dated 10/21/2024 for discussions on a proposed pretrial inmate reduction program is pending with your staff reviewing the proposal. Governor Leon Guerrero has visited our prison facilities, Senator Chris Barnett 37<sup>th</sup> Guam Legislature Public Safety Chairperson has visited our prison facilities, with the most significant purpose of hearing members of the corrections security staff concerns, visually inspecting the prison facilities, and understanding the facility confinement infrastructure security challenges that exist with an increasing population of over three hundred pretrial inmates here at the adult corrections facility (ACF) Mangilao. \*Note this pretrial inmate population is inclusive of the two hundred pretrial inmates confined at Hagatna Detention Facility (HDF) for a total of over five hundred pretrial inmates in our custody awaiting court adjudication processes.

I'm hoping with the completed organizational arrangements for our meeting, General Moylan, that you can visit the ACF, Mangilao to see the extensive security operations applied for mostly pretrial inmates two hundred twenty-four (224) our largest DOC inmate class status population that are housed in tent domes considered the overflow confinement space because HDF has exceeded maximum capacity from a one hundred and thirty-two (132) bed capacity to two hundred and twelve (212) pretrial inmates confined. Additionally, a visit at the women's housing Post #8 that is also reaching over crowded confinement space capacity, and houses mostly pretrial female inmates that outnumber the sentenced convicted female inmates in the same housing unit.
