# Breakdown of the the biggest contract at Purdue University

Purdue has almost 11 million reasons to believe in its head men's basketball coach.

From February 2015 until June 30 of 2019, the end of the fiscal year, Matt Painter will have accumulated

\$10,739,583.35 from the University. On an annual basis, Painter is paid \$2,109,633.50.

Although this may be the single-largest contract at Purdue University, Painter is only the fourth-highest paid men's basketball coach in the Big Ten Conference. Sitting at No. 1 is Michigan State's Tom Izzo

at \$3.49 million, followed by Indiana's Tom Crean at \$3.16 million, and Ohio State's Thad Matta at \$3.2 million.

Senior associate athletics director Tom Schott said Purdue's athletic department observes on-court/field performance as well as the pay of peers when evaluating what to pay coaches.

"Purdue wants to pay its coaches a fair amount based on what they've accomplished and what the market bears," Schott said.

There are a lot of things that go into the \$2,109,633.50 figure. In the 2014-15 fiscal year, Painter's base salary is only \$318,734, roughly 15 percent of his total earnings for the year, with a monthly payment of \$26,561.17.

A large portion of Painter's contract comes in the form of bonuses. His performance bonus base is \$948,963. Incentive-based, weighted bonuses are also obtainable for Painter. For instance, Painter is paid extra for fulfilling quotas set by the athlet-

ic department in terms of graduation success rate and his team's cumulative GPA. He can also earn bonus payments if his team finishes in the top three of the regular season Big Ten standings (10 percent of the performance bonus base for winning, 6 percent for second, and 3 percent for third), as well as winning the Big Ten Tournament.

Painter is also paid 2.5 percent of the performance bonus base for wins in the first two rounds of the tournament, and then 5 percent for any wins in subsequent rounds. If his team advances to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament, Painter qualifies for a minimum bonus payment of 10 percent of the performance bonus base.

Incentive bonuses aside, Painter is also supplied with \$1,500 each month as a stipend for a car. He is also given \$25,000 a year to spend on NIKE clothing. Under Painter's discretion, "the Coach's assistant coaches and support staff may order," according to Painter's contract.
