AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Comes now Affiant, and being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and states that Affiant is a law enforcement officer in Tippecanoe County, State of Indiana, and swears and affirms the following information.

On January 21, 2014 at approximately 12:03 p.m. Purdue Police and West Lafayette Police received several emergency calls about reports of a disturbance and shots fired on Purdue campus in the Electrical Engineering Building. Upon arrival police located several people fleeing from the Electrical Engineering building.

In speaking with initial witnesses police learned that a male subject had fired shots in the Electrical Engineering building in a classroom. Among the first responding officers was Officer Coomey of the West Lafayette Police Department. Officer Coomey located a male subject sitting outside of the Electrical Engineering building on the ground. The subject was sitting on the ground with his hands behind his head. He had blood on his hands and clothes. Coomey took the male subject into custody. The subject was identified as Cody Mark Cousins. Cousins was learned to live at 333 W. Stadium Avenue #2.

Police learned that the events had occurred in Room 067 in the basement of the Electrical Engineering Building. Upon arrival in the area of Room 067 police observed bloody footprints on the floor. Inside Room 067 they found a deceased male subject later identified as Andrew Boldt. His body had sustained knife and gunshot wounds. Police located a handgun on the ground along with several spent shell casings and a knife.

Police interviewed several individuals who were in Room 067 at the time Boldt was killed. Witnesses identified the male later identified as Cousins stabbing and shooting Andrew Boldt. Police also obtained Electrical Engineering building video that showed Cousins' presence in the building.

Affiant and Kevin Coomey are reliable and credible because they are trained law enforcement officers whose observations have been corroborated by multiple witnesses and police investigation.
