

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
TO CONSIDER AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
RAPPAHANNOCK COUNTY CODE, CHAPTER 170, ZONING**

The Rappahannock County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on **February 2, 2026 at 7:00 p.m.**, at the Courthouse located at 250 Gay Street, Washington, Virginia, to consider the following amendments to Rappahannock County Code, Chapter 170, Zoning related to lodging:

- § 170-8, “Definitions,”
- § 170-36, “Permitted uses, special uses and special permits”
- § 170-41, “Temporary mobile home permits”
- § 170-64, “Category 3: Public and Quasi-Public Uses”
- § 170-65, “Category 4: Recreation and Amusement” and
- § 170-66, “Category 5: Commercial, Retail and Business Uses”

The purpose of the ordinance to amend county code is to clarify definitions related to, and requirements for all Transient Lodging and conference center uses currently regulated by the county code.
