NARRATIVE

On 020413 at 0036 hours while on patrol, I observed a red Nissan Frontier [REDACTED] traveling north on Milledge Avenue at Lumpkin Street. The vehicle was weaving from the fog line to the center line. The vehicle then crossed the center line with both drivers' side tires at the intersection of Milledge Avenue and Springdale Street and continued to weave within its lane. I initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and the final for the stop was in the roadway on Waddell Street. As I approached the vehicle, I smelled a strong odor commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle. I advised the driver of the reason for the stop and asked for his driver's license. A GCIC check revealed the driver to be under the age of 21. The driver had glassy and bloodshot eyes and his speech was slurred. I then asked the driver to step from the vehicle. As I spoke with the driver, I smelled a strong odor commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath and person. I asked the driver where he was coming from and he stated International Drive and was going home to the Plaza located on Hill Street. The driver stated that he consumed one beer and two jello shots at approximately 7pm. I then asked the driver if he would perform some voluntary field sobriety exercises and he stated that he would. The driver was wearing jeans, a long sleeve black shirt, and red tennis shoes. I then asked the driver if he had any physical or medical problems that would keep him from walking a straight line or standing on one leg and he stated no. I then asked the driver if he was wearing contacts and he stated no. The field sobriety exercises were performed on a blacktop roadway. The road was level, dry, and was lit by street lights, my patrol vehicle, and flashlight.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN)

I placed the driver in the starting position with his feet together and his hands down by his side. I advised him to follow the tip of my pen with his eyes only. The driver stated that he understood the

instructions. I first checked the driver for equal pupil size (they were) and then for resting Nystagmus (none) and for equal tracking (they tracked together). The driver displayed the following clues:

Lack of smooth pursuit: Both eyes

Distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation: Both eyes

Onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees: Both eyes

Vertical Nystagmus was observed in both eyes

Walk and Turn

I had the driver stand with his feet together and his hands down to his side. I then put the driver in the starting position with his left foot on the line and his right foot in front with his heel and toes touching. The exercise was then demonstrated and he stated that he understood. The driver displayed the following clues:

Used arms to balance (more than six inches from his side)

Starts too soon

One Leg Stand

I put the driver in the starting position and demonstrated the exercise and he stated that he understood. The driver displayed no clues.

Based on my observation of the Vehicle in Motion and the results of the Field Sobriety Exercises, I placed the driver under arrest at 0053 hours for DUI Alcohol (citation #037259), Underage Possession of Alcohol (citation #037260), and Failure to Maintain Lane (citation #037261). The driver was placed into double-locked handcuffs, and I then read him the Georgia Implied Consent Notice for suspects under age 21. The driver stated that he would provide a breath sample. He was then searched incident to arrest and seat belted in the rear seat of Officer Weaver's patrol vehicle (94827). The driver was then transported to the ACCPD downtown prescient where he provided me (permit #32479) a breath sample on the Intoxilyzer 5000 (serial #68-001034) with a result of .129 and .130. The driver was then transported to the Clarke County Jail and released to Jail Personnel. The vehicle was towed by William with Bulldog Towing. My patrol vehicle (94739) is not equipped with an MVR. The Field Sobriety Exercise and the transport is recorded on the MVR from Officer Weaver's patrol vehicle (94827).
