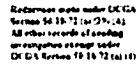
## NARRATIVE

On the listed dates and times I observed a motorcycle leaving the area of downtown at a high rate of speed. I turned around on the motorcycle at Oconee St. and Foundry St. as I started back east bound I saw GSP 169 turnaround in front of me. At this time the motorcycle was at Oconee St. and Williams St. when I got to that intersection I could see a single taillight going up Oconee St. where it splits into Oak St. GSP went down Georgia Dr. and I continued up Oconee St. I turned down China St. where I observed a white male in a with a silver helmet and a black jacket getting off of a motorcycle.

I called out my location and asked Central to get in contact with GSP to see if they got a description of the rider or the motorcycle.

I made contact with the driver of the motorcycle who identified himself as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] told me he was coming from The Grill downtown. I could smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. I could also see that his eyes were bloodshot and watery and that he was swaying while I was speaking to him. I asked how much he had to drink and he told me two pints of beer over a three hour period which meant he was sober. He told me that he was riding the blue Kawasaki tonight because his wasn't running. When GSP 169 arrived he told me that he recognized [REDACTED]. He took over the DUI investigation.

On this date, I responded as backup to assist officers at Bed Bath and Beyond. SPO Simms and SPO Ward were on scene with [REDACTED] at Barnes and Noble. [REDACTED] was walking away as I arrived on scene.

Simms advised that the manager of Barnes and Noble stated he did not have the ability to bar subjects from the parking area. I noted a sign for the property management in a vacant building. As I was talking to Simms a female approached us.

The female was [REDACTED] the original caller. [REDACTED] stated she had parked her gold Lexus SUV at Barnes and Noble. [REDACTED] stated the male we had been out with came up to her window. [REDACTED] stated the male pulled on her door handle and pulled on her cracked window. [REDACTED] stated the male, [REDACTED], told her to give him money. [REDACTED] stated she told him she didn't have any. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] tried her door again, while telling her to get out and go to the ATM and get him \$10. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] told her if she didn't give him money he would grab her hand and break it. [REDACTED] stated she told [REDACTED] she was calling the police.

I was also approached by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she saw [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] vehicle trying to get in. [REDACTED] stated she was scared for [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she grabbed her phone and locked her door because she too was scarred.

Simms and Ward began to check the area for [REDACTED] but could not locate him. CID was notified, and DET Boyle and DET Hamilton responded to the scene. I turned the scene over to them.
