NARRATIVE

On 07-17-13 at 0210 hours while patrolling the West Parking Deck, Corporal Robinson and myself(officer Kirkpatrick) observed two males (Mr. White & Mr. Abell) on the top floor. Both were facing away from the parking deck, looking over the railing/wall but quickly turned when we made the turn to drive up to the upper level of the parking deck. They both had their shirts off but Mr. Abell quickly put his on. Mr. White took out of his pocket what appeared to be a can of Coca Cola and set it on the railing/wall. I drove up alongside where they were standing. I asked them how it was going and what was going on? Mr. White stated that they were just enjoying the view. I stated that it was kind of late for that but got no reply. Corporal Robinson then told me to hold on a minute. Corporal Robinson exited our vehicle and approached Mr. White and Mr. Abell. Corporal Robinson stated "where is the marijuana?, I can smell it". I also smelled an odor that I thought to be marijuana. Both Mr. White and Mr. Abell denied that they had any marijuana but began to empty their pockets and place their personal effects on the railing/wall without being told to do so. I also exited the vehicle and observed Mr. White and Mr. Abell both had bloodshot, glassy eyes. Corporal Robinson and myself began searching the area around them with our flashlights. We observed what appeared to be a very small hand rolled marijuana joint. It was on the railing/wall between both Mr. White and Mr. Abell within arms reach. Corporal Robinson then put Mr. White in handcuffs behind his back and told me to cuff Mr. Abell as well, which I did. I handcuffed Mr. Abell behind his back, making sure there was space for his wrists and then I double locked the cuffs. I also checked by attempting to squeeze the cuffs that the double lock worked. I then read Mr. White and Mr. Abell their Miranda rights, after which I asked them if they understood their rights and they both stated," yes they did". Corporal Robinson then searched Mr. White's pockets and emptied the contents on the railing/wall. He told me to search Mr. Abell. I searched Mr. Abell's pockets and shoes but found nothing, he had already taken his wallet

out and placed it on the railing/wall. I did smell a strong smell of alcoholic beverage from Mr. Abell's person and what I thought to be marijuana. Corporal Robinson again asked them where the marijuana was but got no reply from either Mr. White or Mr. Abell. I noticed that Mr. White looked at the area where all their personal effects were when Corporal Robinson asked the question. I began to look more closely at their items. I noticed that the can of Coca Cola did not appear to be opened. I thought that it seemed odd and picked it up. I immediately noticed that while the weight seemed like a full can of Coca Cola, it did not feel exactly the same as a can of Coca Cola when you moved the weight of it in your hand. I tapped it on the concrete railing/wall and it had a hollow feel. I said "this can of coke feels weird". Corporal Robinson then took the can of what appeared to be Coca Cola and said "you know why it feels weird? I know what this is." He then proceeded to unscrew the top of the can revealing a hidden compartment with marijuana inside. Upon searching Mr. White's wallet a false South Carolina drivers license was found with Mr. White's picture on it. Upon searching Mr. Abell's wallet a real Georgia drivers license not issued to Mr. Abell was found, Mr. Abell refused to answer any questions concerning his possession of that drivers license. Corporal Robinson and myself then gathered all their personal belongings and placed them into evidence bags. They each got a separate bag for their items. We also bagged separately the small marijuana joint. While putting Abell in the patrol vehicle Corporal Robinson noticed the odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages coming from Abell's breath and person. When asked how much he had to drink Abell replied he did not want to answer the question. By running Abell's license through GCIC it was determined that he was under the age of 21. We then took them to the UGA booking facility. While at the University of Georgia Police Department Corporal Robinson asked if Abell would submit to a breath sample and Abell stated he would not. While at the police department a more thorough search of the wallets was conducted to insure no other contraband was in the property. While conducting the search of Mr. Abell's wallet a paper photo copy of Mr. Abell's driver's license was located and the date of birth had been altered to represent Mr. Abell to be over the age of twenty one. Both individuals and their belongings were then transported to Clarke County jail. Our encounter was recorded by Corporal Robinson's flex camera and our transport was recorded with the MVR camera built into our patrol car 95115.

White was charged with misdemeanor possession of marijuana (citation # 040478) and possession of fake ID. Abell was charged with underage possession of alcohol (citation # 040477), misdemeanor possession of marijuana(citation # 040476), and possession of fake ID.

The evidence collected was: From Mr. White, One Coca Cola can safe , One bag of marijuana, One white plastic container with rolling papers, one false Identification card from South Carolina was collected from White and it had his picture on it. From Mr. Abell two identification cards, one for a Todd Ossanna a real Georgia License and a false Georgia Driver's license with Abell's information but

with the date of birth being changed to represent him over the age of 21. Jointly one small marijuana cigarette. All evidence stored in locker #014.

This information is intended to be part of the original.

On 07/17/13 at 0210 hours while patrolling the top level of the West Campus Parking Deck Officer Kirkpatrick and I encountered two males. Upon pulling up in the patrol vehicle I noticed the odor of burning marijuana. The two males were the only two on top of the deck. I then exited my patrol vehicle and approached the two and asked where the marijuana was. The males then, without being told to do so, began to empty their pockets. I then again asked where the marijuana was and that I could smell it on them and in the air. I also observed that both males' eyes were extremely bloodshot. The two stated they did not have any marijuana. Upon viewing the area immediately within the two males reach I located what appeared to be a burnt marijuana cigarette or "roach" lying on the ledge between the two. To keep the two from attempting to destroy it I instructed the two not to move. I then had Officer Kirkpatrick retrieve the suspected burnt marijuana cigarette. Upon retrieving the suspected burnt marijuana cigarette I inspected it with Officer Kirkpatrick and it smelled like burnt marijuana. Officer Kirkpatrick then placed the two males under arrest. The two males were then identified using their driver's license as Collin Abell and Michael White Jr. White was then searched incident to arrest by me at which time I located marijuana inside of a secret compartment inside of a Coca Cola can he had removed earlier from his pocket. I also located rolling papers inside of a white "Johnson and Johnson" plastic container located in his front left pocket and an additional "roach" inside of the container. I then observed a false South Carolina driver's license (SC OLN: 101206123) inside White's wallet with his picture on the driver's license. Abell was searched by Officer Kirkpatrick and a Georgia Driver's license belonging to a Todd Ossanna (GA OLN: 054240427) was located. Both individuals were then read their Miranda Warning by Officer Kirkpatrick. Both individuals refused to answer any questions. While escorting Abell to the rear seat of the patrol vehicle I noticed the odor commonly associated with alcoholic beverages coming from Abell's person and breath. When asked how much he had to drink he stated he was not going to answer any questions. White and Abell were transported to the University of Georgia Police Department to complete paperwork at which time Abell was given the opportunity to give a breath sample. Abell declined. Officer Kirkpatrick then completed writing citations for misdemeanor possession of marijuana on both individuals. Officer Kirkpatrick issued

Abell an additional citation for underage possession of alcohol. A more thorough search of both wallets was performed at the University of Georgia Police Department to ensure no more contraband was found. Upon searching Abell's more thoroughly a false Georgia Driver's license was located. The paper license had been printed on standard paper and the date of birth had been changed to represent Abell as being over the age of 21. The license was in a license holder inside of Abell's wallet. Both Abell and White were charged with possession of fake ID. White and Abell were then transported to the Clarke County Jail where they and their belongings were turned over to the deputies on duty.

The incident and transport were recorded on my Flex Cam. The transport was also recorded on the MVR in vehicle 95115.

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Notes/Narratives**NARRATIVE**

On 7-19-2013, I was parked in the area of Hawthorne Ave and Pauldo St. in Athens GA when I heard a bass beat. Several seconds later, I was passed by a black Nissan Maxima (License Plate BWY 0983) from which the noise was coming. I pulled out behind the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop at the intersection of Oglethorpe Ave and Brooklyn Rd. I approached the vehicle and made contact with the driver, Marcus Ford. After Mr. Ford rolled down his window, I could smell the strong odor associated with alcohol coming from his person. His eyes were also red and glassy. When I asked Mr. Ford for his license, he told me he did not have one. I asked him for his name and DOB, and asked dispatch to confirm his license status. After dispatch confirmed Mr. Ford's license was "Revoked", I asked him to step out of the car. Because I suspected Mr. Ford was DUI, I asked him to submit to SFST to determine if he was under the influence. Mr. Ford refused. I then placed Mr. Ford in handcuffs (double-locked behind the back) and told him he was under arrest for driving on a "Revoked" license. Once Mr. Ford had been taken into custody, I requested dispatch send the "next in line" to tow the vehicle Mr. Ford had been driving. Barretts Towing arrived and towed the vehicle to their lot.

Mr. Ford was transported to the Clarke County Jail where he was transferred into the custody of the Clarke County Sherriff's Office.

On 7/19/13, I was at the intersection of Dougherty and College Avenue.

There was a vehicle on College at the intersection with E Hancock Avenue that was playing very loud music. There were no other vehicles on the roadway and I could hear this music from well over 100 feet away. Once my light turned, I got behind this vehicle (GJC-305/SC) at the red light it was stopped for.

Once the light changed, I turned my overhead lights on and the vehicle pulled to the right next to City Hall.

The vehicle pulled into a parking spot (North/South) and the vehicle was halfway between two parking spots.

I made contact with the driver and identified him as Karan Patel using his Georgia driver's license. I noticed that Patel had marks all over his face on the left side. I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath when he spoke to me. He told me that he had one beer.

I returned to my vehicle and checked his license through GCIC. It was active and valid.

I returned to the driver's side door and asked Patel to exit his vehicle. When he first got out of his vehicle, he was extremely unsteady on his feet and he fell backwards into his door before he was able to steady himself. I noted that he had writing all over his left arm and leg. I asked him if he fell asleep and if his friends drew on him and he answered yes. The writing on his face was found to be a drawing of a penis aimed in the direction of his mouth.

He told me that he had a couple of beers and later clarified it to 3 or 4 beers. He told me that his last drink had been a couple hours ago. As he spoke to me, I noted that his speech was slurred.

I learned that he had been at a party in the Bridgewater subdivision. He was on his way home.

He had an orange paper wristband on his arm and I asked him if he had been downtown before he was at Bridgewater and he told me that he had been.

I explained my observations to him and I asked him if he felt he was safe to drive and he initially told me no. He later told me that he thought he was safe to drive.

I asked him if he would be willing to take some tests so that I could make sure he was safe to drive and he said that he would.

I asked him for a sample on my Alco-Sensor and he agreed to provide a sample. The result was positive for alcohol at .18.

Next, I checked for HGN. His eyes were red and watery.

He was not wearing glasses/contacts, he did not mention any eye problems/head injuries, and he did not indicate that he was under the influence of any prescription medications.

I checked for and observed six of the six validated clues on the HGN. While checking for HGN, he had a very noticeable sway from side to side and from front to back.

Vertical nystagmus was not present.

I started to explain the Walk and Turn Test to Patel. He could not even get his feet together in the starting position because he was so unsteady on his feet. I did not feel that it was safe to go any further, so I stopped the testing for his safety.

I placed him under arrest for DUI and told him that he was under arrest for DUI.

I read him the implied consent test request, over 21, (twice) and after the second reading, he answered no.

At his request, I moved his vehicle forward a few feet so that it was within a parking space. I warned him that he may receive a parking ticket if he is not able to get his vehicle moved and he was fine with this possibility. His vehicle was locked and I transported him to CCSO.

At CCSO, he was booked in for DUI and a vehicle noise violation.

His license was confiscated to be sent in with the DDS-1205 that I served in this incident.

My audio is attached.

There is no video (I recently received a new patrol vehicle and the camera from my old patrol vehicle

has yet to be installed in my new vehicle).
