NARRATIVE

On 04/12/2014 at 1115 hours while on routine patrol, I observed a white 2005 Mitsubishi Lancer ([REDACTED]), a silver 2013 Honda Accord ([REDACTED]), and white 2004 Ford F-150 ([REDACTED]) illegally parked on the sidewalk off Field Street across from the Biology Building. The illegally parked vehicles were forcing pedestrians to walk out into traffic on Field Street because the sidewalk was inaccessible. Attempts were made to contact the owners of all three vehicles but to no avail. [REDACTED] with Jerry's Towing removed the Mitsubishi Lancer and [REDACTED] with Barrett's Towing removed the Honda Accord and Ford F-150. Photos of the violations were taken. Supplement Notes

This information is intended to be part of the original report.

On 04/12/14 at about 1115 hours, Cpl. Martin and Ofc. Graham called out several illegally parked vehicles in the area of Field Street near Sanford Stadium Gate 7. Because one of the vehicles was a UGA vehicle, I responded to the scene to assist.

The UGA vehicle (# [REDACTED]) was parked on the sidewalk and needed to be moved for the following reasons:

- 1.The vehicle was parked on an area that is clearly the sidewalk. It was concrete and separated from the asphalt roadway by a slight gutter.
- 2.People walking up the stairs from East Campus Road and onto the sidewalk at Field Street had to walk into traffic to go around the vehicle, which was completely blocking the sidewalk. Additionally, people walking from the stadium toward East Campus Road had to walk out into the road with one-way traffic on Field Street approaching from behind them. There was a good deal of traffic on Field Street from people circling trying to find a place to park.
- 3.Because of the UGA vehicle parked on the sidewalk, other motorist also began to park there. We had already had problems with other vehicles getting up on the sidewalk in that area in front of and behind the UGA vehicle. We towed two privately-owned vehicles parked on the same sidewalk.
- 4.The UGA vehicle was parked about 2 car lengths from the entrance to gate 7. My fear was that if people saw the vehicle and thought they could park along the sidewalk behind the UGA vehicle, they would start parking in front of Gate 7. If there was an emergency in the stadium that necessitated us opening Gate 7, it would have been blocked by the vehicles.

UGA Police patrol and communications personnel tried the following steps to locate the department responsible for the vehicle to have it moved before resorting to towing:

-11:14 a.m. - Cpl. Martin and Ofc. Graham get out with the truck and three other illegally parked cars

on the Field Street sidewalk.

-11:14 to 11:30 a.m. - Communications found the contact information for the UGA truck ([REDACTED]) but was unable to make contact at the office phone number ([REDACTED]).

-11:32 a.m. - Communications found another phone number for [REDACTED] in the UGA Parking Services directory and attempted to call him. The line was disconnected.

-11:34 a.m. - Communications found a possible cell phone listing for [REDACTED] and tried to call him. The line was disconnected.

-11:38 a.m. - Communications called Biology building contact personnel [REDACTED]. He suggested calling the [REDACTED].

-11:39 a.m. - Communications called the phone number for [REDACTED] and got a recording that the caller was not accepting calls at that time.

-11:40 to 11:45 a.m. - Ofc. Graham went to the room number listed in Biology for [REDACTED]. He knocked on the door but did not make contact with anyone.

-12:05 p.m. - Communications found a phone listing for [REDACTED] with the same home address as [REDACTED]. Communications personnel left a message at that number.

-12:10 p.m. - I made the decision (nearly an hour after we started trying to have it moved) to have the UGA vehicle towed since we were unsuccessful in our attempts to locate anyone who could move the vehicle. I had also checked to see if possibly the vehicle was left unlocked with the keys stored inside. It was locked and I could not see the keys anywhere inside the truck.

I made arrangements with [REDACTED] of Barrett's Towing to have the UGA truck towed to Riverbend Research instead of their impound lot, since UGA vehicles are normally parked at Riverbend Research on UGA football game days.
