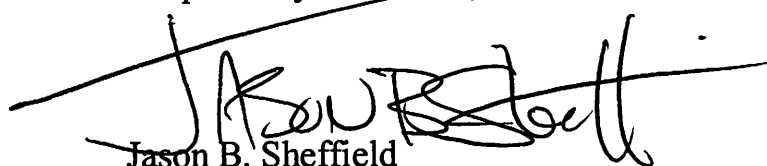

While we disagree with the allegations made by [REDACTED] we know that the University has a very difficult decision to make – one that is not just about balancing the wants and needs of the parties but also those of the University itself. We respect the fact that you must sit in judgment of these facts and want only to help move this case toward a positive ending by taking as many steps toward the middle as possible, without giving up our position of innocence. For this reason, Blake voluntarily submitted himself to these tasks without being ordered to do so by a judge or without being required to do so by the University. In some ways, Blake has done them to confirm to himself and his family that he is the good person we all know him to be.

We are not looking for you to say who is right or who is wrong, Mr. Stevens, only for you to be as fair and balanced as possible and to allow Blake to continue onward and upward at the University of Georgia.

We sincerely appreciate your review of these materials and look forward to meeting with you on Monday, March 7th.

I make the following statement to
OFC COCKBURN and _____, whom I know to be
University of Georgia Police Officers. I understand this statement can later be used against me
in any court of law, and I declare that this statement is made without any threat, coercion, offer
of benefit, favor or offer of favor, leniency or offer of leniency by any person or persons. I
understand that I have a right to have my attorney present as I write this statement and that an
attorney will be appointed to represent me if I cannot afford to hire one. I understand that I may
choose at any time to stop making this statement. Understanding all of the above, I make this
statement voluntarily and of my own free will.

Around 1:00 am on December 3rd I picked my ex-boyfriend,
Blake Wright, up from downtown at Bad Manor.
When I got there he was extremely intoxicated. He got
in my car and everything was fine until he asked to
sleep in my room. I told him I was taking him to
his room. He started flipping me off and yelling
"Fuck you bitch" repeatedly until he calmed down and rested
against the window. At that time I tried to get in
contact with his roommate Will to meet me in the
Russell lot to walk Blake up. As soon as Blake

heard me say Will's name he said "Don't call Will!" He then reached over and grabbed my neck as I was still driving down Finley. I pushed him off and he then grabbed the steering wheel and turned it. He let go of the wheel and brought his arm back to punch me, his hand made contact, but was not forceful due to how intoxicated he was. He slumped over. Once I pulled into the Russell lot he tried to pull the keys from my ignition by the lanyard. He told me he felt sick, opened the car door and left. I had no marks from the incident and he remembers none of it. I went home the next morning and contacted his parents who did nothing. I also contacted his previous girlfriend to see if he had gotten violent with her - she said he had both sober and drunk but she had not reported it. Prior to this incident Blake had been verbally abusive when he was intoxicated by constantly calling me names, but it had never

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escalated physically other than a slight shove
once or twice before he tried to leave a room
when I tried to prevent him from doing
so.

This report contains investigative information intended to be included with the supplemental information for this incident:

[REDACTED] stated that on 120310 at approximately 0045 hours she received a phone call from her ex-boyfriend, Blake Wright, who asked for a ride home from downtown Athens. [REDACTED] stated that when she picked up Wright he was extremely intoxicated and that he asked to be taken to her room. [REDACTED] stated that when she told Wright that she was taking him to his dorm, Russell Hall, he began cursing at her and screaming "fuck you, bitch". Wright then calmed down and seemingly passed out. [REDACTED] stated that when she called Wright's roommate, [REDACTED] ask him to come down to the Russell Hall parking lot to escort Wright up, Wright said "Don't call [REDACTED] and reached over and grabbed her neck with his hand. [REDACTED] stated that his grasp was not very strong due to his intoxicated state. [REDACTED] said that she was not injured by this and there were no visible marks left at the time of the incident or at the time of this report. [REDACTED] stated that she pushed Wright off of her. [REDACTED] stated that Wright then grabbed the steering wheel and made her vehicle swerve. [REDACTED] stated that Wright next pulled back his arm and balled his fist as though he was going to punch her. [REDACTED] stated that Wright was unable to land the punch due to his intoxicated state. [REDACTED] stated that Wright's hand instead brushed her as he fell into her. [REDACTED] next pulled into the Russell Hall parking lot and Wright attempted to pull the keys from the ignition. [REDACTED] stated that Wright then exited her vehicle without further incident.

[REDACTED] stated that she was not injured during this incident and there were no visible injuries.

[REDACTED] stated that Wright has not contacted her following the event.

[REDACTED] signed a prosecution refusal form.

[REDACTED] stated that she felt that the incident should be documented in case of future events.

[REDACTED] provided a written statement.

[REDACTED] stated that Wright frequently spent the night in her dorm room with her.
