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Notes/Narratives**NARRATIVE****INCIDENT RECORDED ON ARBITRATOR**

I was driving westbound on Broad St. near Lumpkin St. and I looked to my right as I drove through the intersection and I saw a grey Ford Escape coming towards me going the wrong direction on Lumpkin St. It was going southbound on Lumpkin near Little Italy. I pulled over to the side of Broad and waited for the vehicle to exit Lumpkin St. and it did turn westbound on Broad headed in my direction. I pulled in behind the vehicle and it made a left turn onto Hull St. I activated my emergency equipment and initiated a traffic stop.

I approached the driver and she acknowledged that she had driven the wrong way on Lumpkin St. I asked her where she had come from to get onto Lumpkin St. and she said Clayton St. I noticed that she was not looking at me when she talked. Her head was facing me, but her eyes were looking off to the side in the distance. She was not looking at me face to face when she talked. I did notice the odor of alcoholic beverage coming from her breath and her eyes were glassy and bloodshot. I asked her for her license and she had a difficult time retrieving it. She had a small zipper purse that hung from her keys and she pulled out credit cards and insurance cards but she could not seem to get her license. Once she had removed all of the contents of said wallet, she so oh there is my license. I asked her how much she had been drinking and she said not much because she was the DD. I did not see any other occupants in her vehicle and I pointed this out to her. She said she had been the DD but then her friends were not ready to leave. I asked her how much was not much drinking and she said two or three Bud Lights at Genco. I asked her what time she started drinking and she said about 10PM. I asked her what time was her last drinking and she said about 11:30 or midnight. I asked her if she was taking prescription drugs and she said no. I asked her to exit the vehicle. Once outside, I asked her if she would take some tests to make sure she was ok to drive and she consented.

HGN: no eye problems, equal tracking and equal pupil size; lack of smooth pursuit, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation, and onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees (6 clues); also VGN observed

WAT: no leg problems; she had on cowboy boots but the heel was not too big and she opted to wear them; started too soon and missed heel to toe (2 clues); her heel to toe mis-steps were due to her steps over-lapping where in most cases it is where a person steps to long

OLS: sway (1 clue); I had to remind her to count out loud and at one point I had to tell her to

straighten her raised leg because her knee had bent

Alcosensor: breath positive for alcohol (.108)

I placed her under arrest for DUI and read implied consent for breath over 21 after confirming her age. She said yes to the breath test. I then read her Miranda and she said she did not wish to talk. Her vehicle was towed by Shumans. She said she had to use the bathroom and could not wait so I took her into the Holiday Inn because I did not want her to soil my vehicle. I then transported her to the East PD for the intox. She began to complain again about having to use the bathroom. I asked her if she could wait about 5 or 10 minutes and she said yes. I set up the intox and her first sample was an invalid sample. I took her to the bathroom and waited 20 minutes for a retest. I explained to her that alcohol makes you have to go to the bathroom. I ran the test again and her breath registered .131 and .130. I then transported her to the jail and left her in their custody. I completed a [REDACTED]

NARRATIVE

On 02-19-2013 at approximately 12:38am I was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a Burglary. Upon arrival I made contact with [REDACTED] who told me that when he got back to his residence he realized that someone had broken into his house and stole his TV.

[REDACTED] stated that he left his house around 8:30am on 02-18-2013 and did not get back until just after midnight on 02-19-2013. [REDACTED] said that in December of last year his residence was broken into. He told me that the perpetrator broke his bedroom window and came in and stole his TV. [REDACTED] said that he did not repair the bedroom window but just put a wood board on the outside to cover up the window and some 2x4 boards on the inside of the window.

Tonight, when [REDACTED] got home, he told me that he saw that the boards had been broke off of the window. [REDACTED] stated that when he entered his residence he noticed that his 42" Insignia TV had been stolen, as well as his DVD player. [REDACTED] did not notice anything else missing.

I dusted for latent prints but was not able to lift any.
