NARRATIVE

On 2/20/13 around 0220 hours I was in my marked police vehicle patrolling the area of College Ave and Strong St. I was driving north on College Ave and I turned right onto Strong St. I noticed a silver Toyota Camry parked on the left side of the road facing the wrong direction. The vehicle was parked at an angle on the left side of the road, and the left front tire was sitting right next to the sewage drain near the curb. The rear of his vehicle was in the crosswalk, and in the center of the lane. The vehicle did not have its lights on or have its emergency flashers on. I pulled to the right side of the road so I could get out and speak with the male in the driver's seat.

Matan Becker was the male in the car, and when I approached the passenger side of the vehicle he had his head down looking at his cell phone. I called out to Central Communications that I would be out with a suspicious vehicle at that location. SPO Carroll let Central know that the tag on the car read [REDACTED]. Becker rolled the passenger window down and he immediately told me he was out of gas and that his friend was coming to help him out. SPO Carroll approached the driver's window and asked what was going on. Becker said that he ran out of gas and that he could not go anywhere. SPO Carroll said that he was concerned with where the car was parked near that intersection. I asked for Becker's driver's license so I could have Central run his name through GCIC. SPO Carroll then asked Becker where he was coming from. Becker said that he was down town at a bar hanging out with his friends. SPO Carroll asked how much he had to drink, and Becker said that he only had two drinks. Central came back with Becker's name and they said the vehicle had active registration, valid insurance, and that he did not have any warrants.

SPO Carroll asked if Becker would step outside of the vehicle, which he did. When he stopped out of the vehicle I noticed his clothing was disheveled; his shirt was not fully tucked into his pants and I noticed his pants was unzipped. Becker's eyes looked very glassy and I noticed they were red as well. SPO Carroll asked Becker again how much he had to drink and Becker said he had two or three drinks. When he was speaking to us on the curb I could smell an odor coming from his breath commonly associated to an alcoholic beverage. SPO Carroll asked Becker what he had to drink and he said he had a mixed drink, a beer, and then another beer. Becker kept putting his hands inside his pockets, after we told him to keep his hands out of his pockets numerous times. We asked him this for our safety, because we did not know if he had any weapons or something else that could harm us.

SPO Carroll asked Becker if he would agree to doing some tests for us, but he questioned if he could wait until his friend came before that happened. We said that we wanted to do the tests because we were concerned that he was less safe to drive with the amount of alcohol he had to drink. Becker refused to do the field tests. Then SPO Carroll asked Becker if he would submit to an Alco-Sensor test, which would indicate the presence of alcohol on his breath. Becker asked if there would be any

consequences for refusing the Alco-Sensor, and then said that he did not want to do it.

I arrested Becker (double locked/behind the back) for driving under the influence of alcohol. I searched Becker incident to arrest and placed him into the back of the patrol vehicle. With the back seat door of the patrol vehicle open, I read to Becker the Georgia Implied Consent Notice for suspects age 21 or over (orange card) specifying breath for the state test. He interrupted me and said he did not understand. I read implied consent a second time, and on the last sentence Becker interrupted me and said he did not understand. I asked him if he wanted me to read implied consent a third time and he said yes. I read it to him and he said no, refusing the test.

Oldham's towing came to pick up the vehicle and towed it to their lot.

I ran the vehicle tag [REDACTED] through GCIC and it showed that a different tag [REDACTED] should actually be the one displayed on the vehicle. Becker stated that he knew that information and the new tag was at his parent's house in Atlanta.

I transferred Becker to Clarke County Jail. I wrote Becker a citation for Improper Tag on Vehicle (Citation #328346) and a citation for driving under the influence of alcohol (Citation #328347). I completed a License Suspension form, which I explained to him what it was, and gave Becker a copy. He was turned over to the SO.
