CONSENT ORDER

In this Court's Order [138] of March 3, 2009, Defendants in the above-captioned action were ordered to expunge from their files any materials relating to findings by the University of Georgia, its officers, the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia, or its officers, that Plaintiff Dr. John Soloski had violated the University's Non-Discrimination Anti-Harassment ("NDAH") policy.

To effect that Order, the parties indicate their consent to the following paragraph of this Order:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that all documents relating to the allegations, investigation, or resolution of the NDAH matter involving Dr. John Soloski, or which may otherwise reference or discuss the matter which was the subject of this suit, shall be removed from any and all personnel files maintained by the University of Georgia or the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia that contain the personnel records of Dr. Soloski.

Though Defendants have not consented to this paragraph of this Order, the Court finds it necessary to properly effect the preceding paragraph. Accordingly, **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that neither this Order nor any other document shall be placed in any file referencing the removal, pursuant to this Order, of documents from that file.
