- ☐ Go on a scavenger hunt

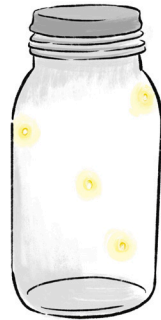
Have a scavenger hunt with a checklist of things to find around town.

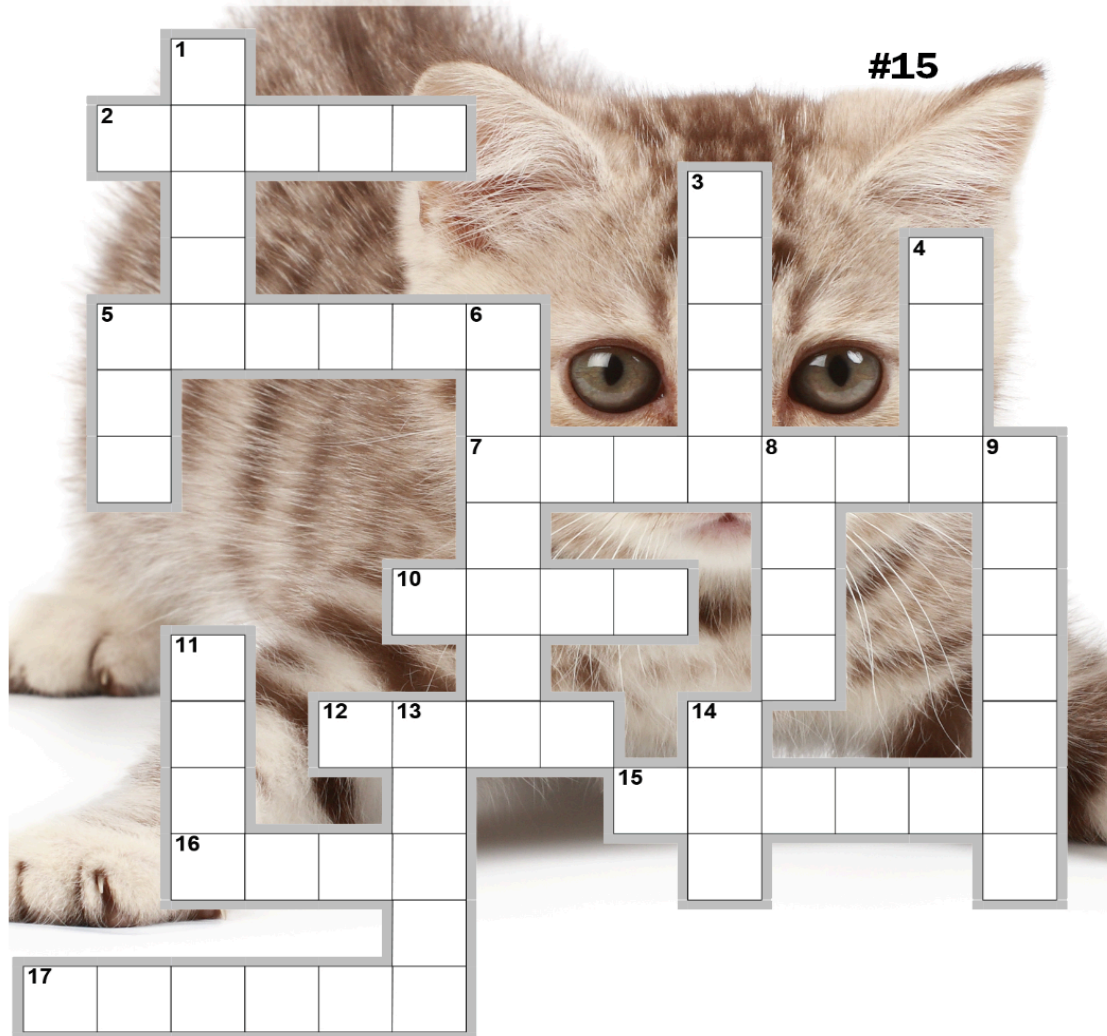
