Notes/Narratives

NARRATIVE

I responded to Red Oak Apartments (232 Epps Bridge Road) unit 14A in reference to a domestic disturbance. While enroute (central) advised that the reporting female caller stated that her boyfriend was throwing her property down the stairs. The female caller further advised that she was involved in a verbal argument. I arrived on scene a few moments later and as I entered the complex I noticed a male and female carrying clothing across the parking lot. I parked my vehicle and decided to approach them on foot, they were unaware of my presence. I approached the front door of unit 14A, which was wide open, and I observed a fairly large pile of clothes on the floor and I noticed a female picking them up and trying to organize them. I greeted the female, later identified as Kathryn Marie Sullivan (Dob [REDACTED] 86), and she advised that she called. When asked, Sullivan advised that she was having an argument with her boyfriend and they were now in the process of breaking up. She advised that during the course of their argument, her boyfriend started to grab her clothes and belongings and threw them down the stairs. She had already retrieved them, prior to my arrival, and she denied that there was any physical altercation or contact between them. When asked, Sullivan advised that they have been living here together for about (9) months, and they had also previously lived together in Winder, Ga. for over a year.

At this point the involved boyfriend, later identified as Cason Farmer (Dob [REDACTED] 88), approached the front door and I spoke with him as well. When asked, he acknowledged that they had been involved in a verbal argument and he admitted that he had grabbed her clothes and threw them down the stairs. He further advised that he told her "to get out." Farmer also confirmed that they have been living together for the past (2) years. I advised him that this was her residence and he would have to evict her. He stated he understood. As I spoke with Farmer he also advised that, during their verbal argument, he demanded that Sullivan return a watch to him. He stated that Sullivan grabbed the watch and threw it at him, striking him in the upper left chest. At this point he pointed to his upper chest and advised that he had a swollen, reddish, mark on the left side of his chest. As I looked at his chest I noticed a red, circular, mark. Farmer held up the watch to his chest and I noticed that the circular mark, or pattern, matched the size and shape of the watch. Farmer advised that he was not interested in pursuing this matter. At this point SPO Johnson arrived on scene. He was witness to Farmer's claim and he also observed the red colored mark. I asked Farmer where this occurred and if anyone had witnessed her throw the watch at him. He stated that it happened in their upstairs bedroom and no one else had witnessed it, but he advised that he immediately spoke with his roommates and the observed the mark. Farmer escorted SPO Johnson and I upstairs and to their shared bedroom. Once there he pointed towards the area where their argument had occurred. Farmer stated that he was on one side of the bed and Sullivan was on the other. He stated that as they argued he told her to return a watch that he had purchased for her. he stated that Sullivan grabbed the watch and threw it at him, striking his chest. He denied that there was any other contact between them and I did not observe anything evidence of such. The room did not appear to be in disarray and there was no visible damage.

Both roommates, identified as [REDACTED], were on scene and I spoke with them. When asked, both [REDACTED] confirmed Farmer's version. They advised that they were upstairs, in their room, when Farmer approached them and told them that Sullivan had thrown a watch at his chest. They both advised that they also noticed the red colored mark on his chest.

At this point I again spoke with Sullivan. Initially, she advised that she handed the watch to Farmer and denied

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throwing it, but when I asked her about his allegation that she had thrown the watch and the visible mark on his chest, she changed her version slightly. Sullivan now admitted that she "tossed" the watch at him and she made a 'throwing motion' as she spoke. I explained the domestic violence criteria to Sullivan and she stated she understood. It should also be noted that both Sullivan and Farmer were cooperative and they did not appear to be under the influence of either alcohol or drugs and there was no evidence of such.

I again met with Farmer and I took digital photos of his injury. It should be noted that the visible mark was slightly swollen and red. It was visible to the eye, however, the injury was difficult to photograph, due to the lighting conditions. Farmer also provided a sworn written statement of this incident. I explained the domestic violence criteria to him as well, and he was provided a victims notification form, which he filled out and retained his copy.

At this point I again met with Sullivan and I advised her that she was under arrest. She was handcuffed (D/L-B/B) and secured in the back of my cruiser for transport. A short time later she was transported to the CCSO Jail and turned over to the custody of jail staff, without incident.
