NARRATIVE

On 09/03/2013 at 23:32 hours Cpl. Duffell and I were dispatched to Russell hall at 515 Baxter Street in reference to the smell of marijuana coming from one of the rooms on the north wing second floor hallway. Cpl. Duffell arrived and was taken to the room by the reporting party and RA on duty, Rahul Kadakia, who stated that he thought the smell, was coming from room [REDACTED]. Mr. Kadakia stated that he had at first been told of the presence of the smell of marijuana by the RA Victor Lopez-Henriquez. Mr. Kadakia escorted Cpl. Duffell and I to the suspected room and Cpl. Duffell smelled the odor of marijuana coming from room [REDACTED] and he called me over the door and I smelled in between the separation of the door and smelled a strong odor of marijuana. I knocked on the door and a Burch Scott Mixon opened the door. The smell of marijuana got stronger as the door was opened and I introduced myself and Cpl. Duffell to Mixon. I advised Mixon that we were there because of the smell of marijuana that was in the hall and it had been narrowed down to be coming from his room. Cpl. Duffell asked Mixon if we could come into the room and search for any contraband or related items and Mixon stated that we could not come in his room. Cpl. Duffell called the other individual that was sitting on the couch in the room out into the hallway and he was identified as Carter Ross Wiles. I asked Wiles if this was his room also and he stated that it wasn't. Cpl. Duffell advised Mixon and Wiles that they need to exit the room while we went to attempt to obtain a search warrant. Cpl. Duffell called Officer Browning over to watch the individuals while we went to attempt to obtain a search warrant.

Cpl. Duffell wrote the search warrant at the University of Georgia Police Department and Cpl. Duffell called the on-call Judge Barron. Cpl. Duffell and I went to the residence of Judge Barron and got the search warrant signed.

After obtaining a signed search warrant, on 09/04/2013 at 0143 hours, Cpl. Duffell and I returned to Russell Hall at 515 Baxter Street and Mixon and Wiles each were given a copy of the search warrant before the search began. Cpl. Duffell and I were assisted in the search by SPO Smith, Cpl. Vickery, and Officer Browning. Officer Browning stated that as he was watching the individuals while Cpl. Duffell and I were obtaining a search warrant, he asked Mixon and Wiles what state they had their driver's license in. Officer Browning stated that both individuals told him they had North Carolina driver's licenses. Officer Browning then stated that he had noticed a South Carolina driver's license sitting under Mixon as he was sitting outside the room on the floor. Officer Browning stated that he asked for Mixon to give him the driver's license and Officer Browning ran it through UGA communications and it returned to be fraudulent. While searching the room I found a small blue bag with a zipper located in the top of Mixon's closet behind a large pile of towels. After removing the blue bag and opening it I removed a silver grinder and an orange pill bottle. I called Officer Browning over to help examine the items and there was marijuana residue in the grinder and suspected marijuana in the orange pill bottle.

During the search of Russell Hall room [REDACTED] the following items were found:

- "1 GA driver's license [REDACTED] found in wallet
- "1 fake South Carolina driver's license [REDACTED] found on Mixon
- "1 small black bag containing marijuana residue, a marijuana holder with pipe containing marijuana residue, a pack of rolling paper, and a cigarette rolling tool
- "1 baggie of suspected marijuana in an airbourne medication tube found on black cabinet
- "1 mechanical pen with marijuana residue found on blackcabinet
- "1 metal flask with initials BSM on the side and a smell commonly associated with alcohol found on desk
- "10 Blue Moon beer bottles, 2 empty Blue Moon beer bottles, 1 Bud light beer bottle (13 total) found in mini fridge
- "1 blue case containing marijuana residue, marijuana grinder containing suspected marijuana, an orange pill bottle containing suspected marijuana found in closet
- "1 fake New York driver's license [REDACTED] obtained from the wallet of Carter Ross Wiles found in wallet
- "1 marijuana grinder with suspected marijuana found on black cabinet

Digital pictures were taken of all the items in the specific places they were found in Russell Hall room [REDACTED]. All the items found were placed into a brown evidence bag for transport back to the UGA Police Department.

As a result of these items being discovered, the offenders were charged as follows:

- "Burch Scott Mixon- Underage possession of alcohol (O.C.G.A 3-3-23), Possession of a fake I.D. (O.C.G.A 16-9-4), Possession of Marijuana (O.C.G.A. 16-13-30) , and Possession of Drug related Objects (O.C.G.A 16-13-32.2).
- "Carter Ross Wiles - Possession of fake I.D. (O.C.G.A. 16-9-4) , Possession of Marijuana (O.C.G.A. 16-13-30), and Possession of Drug Related Objects (O.C.G.A. 16-13-32.2).

Mixon and Wiles were arrested on scene and were handcuffed behind the back, double locked, searched incident to arrest, and were taken to Clarke County Jail.

Mixon's roommate [REDACTED] was not on scene and we attempted to contact him without success. No charges against [REDACTED] are anticipated at this time.

Digital pictures were taken of the scene and all the items seized as evidence.

On 090313 at 2346 hours I was requested by CPL Duffell to stand by with the occupants of room [REDACTED] in Russell Hall. CPL Duffell was conducting a marijuana investigation and needed an officer to wait with the occupants while he prepared a search warrant for the premises and occupants.

When I arrived on scene I met with CPL Duffell, Ofc Echols, two RA's and the occupants of the room (Mixon and Wiles). As I was walking up the stairs from the entrance of Russell Hall leading to the second floor where the elevators are located I immediately recognized the odor of burnt marijuana. The odor grew stronger as I made my way into the corridor for "Two North" and was easily detectable coming from within room [REDACTED] (the door was standing open when I arrived). CPL Duffell and Ofc Echols left to begin the search warrant process and I explained to Mixon and Wiles that the attempt at getting a search warrant may take up to several hours and they were welcome to sit on the floor if they wanted to get comfortable. At approximately 2359 hours while waiting to hear from CPL Duffell I was observing the movements of both Mixon and Wiles as they sat on the floor. Dispatch had only moments before requested I ask Both Mixon and Wiles what state their driver's licenses were issued from. Both stated North Carolina.

As I watched Mixon I noticed a South Carolina driver's license lying on the floor by his left thigh. Having just been told that his license was issued out of North Carolina I asked Mixon what the license on the floor was. Mixon stated, "It fell out of my pocket." Mixon then placed it in his pocket again. I then directed Mixon to give the license to me. The license was issued by the State of South Carolina to Burch Mixon. I radioed the OLN to dispatch and the results showed file not available. Mixon then admitted to me that the ID was a fake. I placed the license in my shirt pocket and held it until Ofc Echols returned in order to place in his custody, as he was in charge of the scene.

At 0143 hours CPL Duffell and Ofc Echols arrived on scene with signed search warrants. CPL Vickery and SPO B. Smith also arrived to assist with the search. Both Mixon and Wiles were given copies of the search warrants and I began a search of Wiles' person. No property and no contraband were found on

Wiles' person. I then entered room [redacted] to help with execution of the search warrant on the property.

I located an empty Natural Light beer can in a trash can on the side of the room belonging to Mixon's roommate who was not present at any time during this incident. The RA's on scene were made aware of the beer can. I did not find any other contraband nor did I personally find any evidence related to the nature of the call. After all evidence was collected and photographed I disposed of 10 unopened Blue Moon Beer bottles and 1 unopened Bud Light bottle. There were also two empty Blue Moon bottles with these items. All 11 unopened bottles were taken by me to the men's room located on the hall and were poured into the sink. The bottles were rinsed clean and placed into a trash receptacle in the men's room.

I then returned to the room and waited until CPL Duffell finished his investigation. I helped escort both Mixon and Wiles to CPL Duffell's patrol car. At this time I retrieved Wiles' personal effects and inventoried the money in his wallet. I counted \$80.00 US currency. After Mixon and Wiles were secured my role in this incident was completed.

On 090313 at approximately 2332 hours, Officer Echols and I were dispatched to Russell Hall in reference to a report of the smell of marijuana on the second floor. Upon our arrival we met with the reporting party outside the doorway to the north wing of the second floor of Russell Hall. I noted that I could smell an odor which I associated with burning marijuana at this location. The reporting party stated that he had been called by Victor Lopez-Henriquez (Graduate Assistant) after Lopez-Henriquez had received a complaint about the odor of marijuana on the north wing of the second floor. The reporting party stated that he came to the second floor north wing and he too smelled an odor which he associated with marijuana. The reporting party stated that while in the area he had overheard other residents on the hallway talking about the resident(s) in room [REDACTED]. The reporting party also stated that as he walked by the door to room [REDACTED] he heard the door lock latch. The reporting party reported that he believed room [REDACTED] possibly be the source of the odor. The reporting party escorted us to the area and I noted that the odor of marijuana seemed to have dissipated from the area. Officer Echols and I began to smell around the various room doors on the hallway in an attempt to locate the source of the odor. I placed my face near the separation between the door and the doorframe to room [REDACTED]. I noted that there was air flowing through the separation and I could smell the odor which I associated with burning marijuana which seemed to be coming from inside the room. Prior to the date of this incident, I have received training in the detection and recognition of the odor of both burning and green marijuana. I noted that once the door to room [REDACTED] was opened that I could smell a strong odor which I associated with burning marijuana which seemed to be coming from room [REDACTED] and which was now filling the hallway. Officer Echols explained the reason for our presence to Mixon (Being to investigate the odor of marijuana). Officer Echols and I asked the occupants of room [REDACTED] Mixon and Wiles) to step into the hallway. I asked Mixon (The resident of room [REDACTED] Wiles according to UGA records is a resident of Creswell Hall) for consent to search his room in connection with our investigation but he refused consent. Mixon's roommate [REDACTED] was not on scene at this time. I asked Senior Police Officer Browning to come to our location and standby with Mixon and Wiles and secure the room while

Officer Echols and I left in order to attempt to obtain a search warrant.

Officer Echols and I came to the University of Georgia Police Department and I prepared a search warrant / affidavit to search room [REDACTED] of Russell Hall as well as the persons of Mixon and Wiles. Upon completion of the warrant and affidavit, Officer Echols and I met with Athens-Clarke County Magistrate Court Judge Barron at her residence. I swore before Judge Barron the information contained in the search warrant / affidavit and Judge Barron and I both signed the search warrant. Officer Echols and I then returned to the University of Georgia Police Department where I made copies of the original warrant. Officer Echols and I then returned to room [REDACTED] of Russell Hall. I allowed all officers present (SPO B. Smith, Cpl. Vickery, and SPO Browning) to inspect the search warrant order. I also provided copies of the search warrant order to Mixon and Wiles. Mixon and Wiles were searched by other officers on scene and I began, assisted by other officers, to search room [REDACTED] of Russell Hall. During my search, I opened a wallet located on the dresser on the left hand side of the room if viewing the room from the hallway. Inside the wallet, I discovered a driver's license issued to [REDACTED] (Mixon's roommate). I noted that the date of birth indicated that [REDACTED] was under the age of 21. I also discovered inside the wallet another Georgia driver's license issued to [REDACTED] A OLN: [REDACTED]. I noted that this name did not correspond to the residents of room [REDACTED] Russell Hall. I also noted that the date of birth on this license indicated a date of birth that was over the age of 21. I know that based upon my training, knowledge, and experience that possession of another person's identification in such a manner by someone under the age of 21 is consistent with the use of the other person's identification for the unlawful purpose of misrepresenting one's age and identity in order to gain access to bars and/or obtain alcoholic beverages while under the age of 21. I seized the license for the purpose of returning it to its rightful owner. Although attempts were made to contact [REDACTED] he did not respond and did not return to room [REDACTED] during our investigation. No criminal charges are anticipated against [REDACTED] at this time.

I assisted other officers in processing the evidence collected during our search. A quantity of beer was located in the room during our search. As both residents of room [REDACTED] and Wiles were under the age of 21 the beer was documented and destroyed. I also subjected a quantity of the suspected marijuana found to a presumptive test. The substance tested positive by color change on the presumptive test for marijuana.

Upon completing our search, I asked that Mixon step into room [REDACTED] I read Mixon the Miranda Warning and he stated that he understood his rights. I informed Mixon of the items which we had

found and asked if the items we had found were his to which he replied, "Yes, sir". I also asked Mixon if these items were why he had initially refused consent to search his room to which he nodded in the affirmative. I asked Mixon if anything which we had found belong to Wiles to which he replied, "No, sir". I informed Mixon that he was under arrest and Officer Echols placed Mixon into double-locked handcuffs behind his back.

I then asked that Wiles step into the room. I read Wiles the Miranda Warning and he stated that he understood his rights. I showed Wiles a wallet (Which contained his driver`s license and other personal effects) in which a fraudulent driver`s license had been found during our search. I asked Wiles if it was in fact his wallet to which he replied that it was. I also showed Wiles the fraudulent driver`s license which bore his name to which he replied, "It`s not real". I asked Wiles if he knew that it was illegal to possess a fraudulent driver`s license to which he replied that he did know that. I asked why he had the fraudulent driver`s license to which he replied, "I`m sure you know why I have it". I asked Wiles if him and Mixon had been smoking marijuana in the room to which he replied, "Yes, sir". I asked Wiles how long it had been since they had smoked prior to Officer Echols knocking on the door to which he replied that it had been about 10 minutes. I asked Wiles how me knew Wiles and [REDACTED] to which he replied that they were "Pledge brothers". I asked Wiles how they had been smoking the marijuana to which he replied that they had used the "Vaporizer" which we had located during our search. I asked Wiles who had the marijuana they had been smoking to which he replied that Mixon had supplied the marijuana they had been smoking. I asked Wiles if he had brought anything which they had used to which he replied, "That little grinder is mine". Wiles denied having consumed alcoholic beverages and I noted no obvious signs of alcohol impairment during my interactions with him. I then advised Wiles that he was under arrest and Officer Echols placed Wiles into double locked handcuffs behind his back.

A copy of the search warrant order was left inside room [REDACTED]

Officer Echols escorted Wiles and Mixon to our patrol vehicle. Wiles and Mixon were placed into the rear seat of our patrol vehicle. Officer Echols and I transported Wiles and Mixon to the Athens-Clarke County Jail. Once at the jail, Officer Echols completed the arrest paperwork on Mixon and I allowed him to stand outside the vehicle until Officer Echols could complete the arrest paperwork for Wiles. I continued to speak with Mixon and asked him if it was difficult to obtain alcohol with a fraudulent ID like the one which SPO Browning had recovered from him. Mixon replied that it was not difficult to obtain alcohol from gas stations using the ID and stated that he had purchased the Blue Moon brand beer which we had found from a gas station.

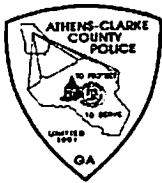
