NARRATIVE

On 02/06/2013 at 0134 hours while conducting a foot patrol of the Founder's Garden I heard what I believed to be breaking glass coming from the area of the Old Phi Kappa parking lot. I scanned the area and observed a white male accompanied by a white female standing in the Old Phi Kappa parking lot near a black Chevrolet Silverado truck [REDACTED]. As I watched the two individuals in the lot the male subject, later identified as Gibson Schoen, kicked the rear driver's side wheel of the black truck. After kicking the rear wheel, Schoen then kicked the truck again near the front of the rear fender well and later kicked the driver's side corner of the front bumper. As Schoen kicked the truck the female subject, later identified as Deanna Wallace, was standing near the truck with Schoen. After kicking the truck Schoen and Wallace exited the lot onto Hull Street where they continued to walk south bound on the sidewalk. I called out a description of Schoen and Wallace and at 0135 hours Officer Alford made contact with the two individuals on the sidewalk near the Special Collections Library on Hull Street.

Schoen was escorted to the Old Phi Kappa parking lot where I made contact with him. Upon speaking with Schoen he informed me that he, "Honestly I can't remember if I kicked the truck." Schoen was asked if he walked through the lot and he informed me that he had not walked through the lot. Schoen stated that he walked from downtown by way of Hull Street. As Schoen spoke to me I could smell a strong odor commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. Schoen's speech was slow and slurred. At one point Schoen stated, "My truck lives in the WOC lot". When I asked Schoen if he had an ID on his person he handed me a Texas driver's license issued to [REDACTED]. A GCIC check of the Texas License confirmed that the license was a valid license issued to [REDACTED]. Schoen stated later that [REDACTED] was a fraternity brother of his and that [REDACTED] did not know he had his license in his possession. Schoen also stated that he had used the Texas license to enter a bar down town where he purchased and consumed alcohol. A GCIC check of Schoen's Georgia OLN confirmed that he was under the age of 21. Schoen was placed under arrest at 0154 hours.

Wallace was asked if Schoen had kicked the black truck in the lot. Wallace stated that she couldn't remember if Wallace had kicked the truck, but she did confirm that the two of them had walked through the lot to gain access to Hull Street from Lumpkin Street. As Wallace spoke to me I could smell a strong odor commonly associated with an alcoholic beverage coming from her breath. Wallace informed me that she had consumed alcohol prior to me making contact with her. A GCIC check of Wallace's Georgia OLN confirmed that she was under the age of 21. Sgt. Pennington asked Wallace how she obtained alcohol being that she was under the age of 21. Wallace stated that she obtained alcohol in a bar. Later Wallace stated that she entered a bar using an ID she had. Sgt. Pennington

asked her to provide him with the ID she used to enter the bar and Wallace provided Sgt. Pennington with a [redacted] driver's license issued to a [redacted]. A GCIC check of the [redacted] License revealed that the [redacted] OLN was issued to a [redacted], and that the license was also expired. The GCIC information confirmed that the [redacted] license Wallace was in possession of was fraudulent. Wallace was placed under arrest at 0201 hours.

Schoen and Wallace were both informed that they were being charged with underage possession of alcohol and possession of a fraudulent ID. Both were placed in double locked handcuffs and searched incident to arrest. Schoen was searched by me, and afterward was seat belted in the rear seat of Officer Haas' patrol vehicle for transport to the Clarke County Jail. Officer Haas read Schoen his Miranda Warning and asked him to provide a sample of his breath for testing. Schoen refused to provide a sample of his breath. Due to Wallace being so upset at the time of her arrest she was not read Miranda, and thus was not further questioned about the incident.

Wallace was searched by Officer Hamsley and then seat belted in the rear seat of her patrol vehicle for transport to the Clarke County Jail. At the Jail both Schoen and Wallace were turned over to jail personnel for processing. Wallace belonging's consisted of a set of keys, a brown wallet, and a black cell phone. Wallace belonging's consisted of a black purse. There are two MVR videos, and one audio recording attached to this report. Dispatch made contact with the owner of the black Chevrolet truck, who advised that she was not in Athens. The owner was given the CRN for this incident and was advised to contact the Department to report any damage to her vehicle when she returned to Athens. At the time of this report photos of the three foot prints left by Schoen on the vehicle were taken on scene. Several small scratches were observed in and around one of the foot prints, but at the time of this report without the owner on scene it could not be confirmed that the scratches were new damage.
