**NARRATIVE**

On 110913 at approximately 1228 hours, while traveling west on Cedar St at Food Science I observed that the driver (Enright, Patrick Joseph) of a 2006 Grey Nissan Titan [REDACTED] driving east bound was not wearing his seat belt. I turned my motorcycle around and turned on my lights to initiate a traffic stop on the vehicle. The vehicle stopped at the intersection of East Campus Rd. While stopped ACCPD Officer Lusk, who was working traffic direction began to approach the driver. She looked over at me and yelled that Enright was stuffing something into the door jam. The vehicle turned south onto East Campus Rd. As we were approaching Tucker Hall, I activated my siren to further signal Enright to stop his vehicle. The vehicle finally pulled into the Tucker Hall bus stop.

I made contact with Enright while he was still seated in the driver's seat of the vehicle and he did not have his seat belt on. He was the only occupant. I introduced myself and then explained the reason for the stop. Enright stated that the reason that he had not been buckled up was that he was dropping some friends off at the game and had not really thought about wearing his seat belt. I then asked him for his driver's license and he stated that he did not have it because it was in his friend's truck. I then asked him if he had his wallet and he stated "no sir." I then asked Enright if there was anything in his door and he stated that there was not and that he had been attempting to put on his seat belt. I asked him again if there was anything in his door and he stated that there was not. I then asked him if he would mind opening the door and showing me and he stated "huh yeah." Enright then opened his door from the inside of his vehicle without any further prompting. When he opened the door, I observed a clear plastic Ziploc bag with what appeared to me to be green marijuana. When asked, Enright stated that the bag was not his. At that point I asked Enright to step from the vehicle.

I had him move to the side walk behind his truck. I called for backup to come to my location. The driver advised me that no one had driven his vehicle today. Once Cpl. Mortensen arrived on scene I

conducted a probable cause search of the vehicle. The search yielded the following items:

- Clear plastic baggie of green marijuana from driver's side front door pocket
- Suspected piece of green marijuana from driver's side front floor board
- Loose unmarked white pill from inside of the center console
- Partial bottle of Bacardi vodka under the front passenger seat

I photographed these items and collected them for evidence. The vodka was ultimately poured out into the grass next to the bus stop and the bottle was thrown into the trash. Before speaking with Enright again, I read him his Miranda warning. He stated that he understood it. During our conversation Enright that stated that he had touched the bag of marijuana before, but that he had forgot that it was in his truck. He also stated that he did not remember buying the vodka, but it might be his. I then placed Enright under arrest for No Seat belt (#041370), No License on Person (#041371), Under Age Possession of Alcohol (#041372), and Possession of Marijuana less than one ounce (#041373). I placed Enright in double locked behind the back handcuffs. Before searching him I asked Enright if there was anything else on him that I needed to know about, and he stated that he had a fake id. I located a fake NC Driver's license with his picture and information in the identification card slot of his wallet that was in his left pocket. I asked Enright if his driver's license was in his wallet, and he stated no. He stated that it was just a wallet. I asked him how many wallets he has and he stated two. I asked him if this wallet was his going out wallet and he stated yes sir. I asked him was that why his fake was in it and he stated yes sir. At that point, I decided to also charge Enright with possession of fake identification. The fake id was taken into evidence. When asked, Enright stated that he uses the fake id to get into bars.

When Officer Wood arrived on scene I turned Enright over to him. Wood secured him in the rear seat of his patrol vehicle. Enright was transported to the Clarke County Jail where he, his wallet containing \$4.25, and cell phone were turned over to Deputy Seay (6413).

While on scene, I performed a field test on the marijuana found in the clear plastic bag in the driver's door and it tested a presumptive positive. While at the UGA PD I tested the loose suspected marijuana and it did not return a positive result. All of the items of evidence except the bottle of vodka were placed into evidence locker #14.

Enright had called one of his friends to come and get his vehicle, but after waiting over 30 minutes the friend never showed up. The vehicle ended up being towed by Travis with Barrett's to thier impound lot.

This incident was recorded on my flex camera.

On 11113 at approximately 0835 hours, Judge Pomerane of the ACC Magistrate Court signed a

**NARRATIVE**

On 11/09/13 at 1315 hours a concerned citizen approached me on Herty Drive in reference to two people removing tailgate items. The concerned citizen stated that there were two white males stealing tailgate items from the area of the North Quad while the tailgaters were in the stadium for the home football game. I made contact with one individual that matched the description given by the concerned citizen on the front steps of the Academic Building.

The individual, later identified as [REDACTED] was stacking tailgate items in a pile in the corner of the exterior stairs on the front of the Academic Building. I noticed that there was a large pile of camping chairs and coolers. I advised [REDACTED] about the complaint that I received. He stated that he took the items from various spots on the North Quad and placed them in a pile so that he and his friends could take the items home when he arranged for transportation. [REDACTED] stated that he thought it was acceptable to take the tailgate items since the owners had left them behind to go to the game. I advised [REDACTED] that the owners may have left their items on the North Quad with the intent to retrieve them when they returned to the game. [REDACTED] stated that he understood this.

Due to the fact that [REDACTED] had gathered approximately 20 folding camping chairs and two folding tables along with multiple coolers containing food, beverages (alcohol, Gatorade, water, etc.), and clothing items with the intent to take possession of the items, I advised him that I would be barring him from campus. [REDACTED] was barred from all University of Georgia property for a period of 2 years at the approval of Sgt. Seawright. [REDACTED] received a copy of the barring notice and stated that he understood it. I took a photo of [REDACTED] for the notice.

I asked [REDACTED] to put all of the tailgate items back on the North Quad in the areas from which he removed them. [REDACTED] placed all of the items back in their places to the best of his memory. There

were two large Igloo coolers (1 red, 1 blue) that [redacted] assured me were his. [redacted] allowed me to look into the coolers. They contained food and beverages. [redacted] also stated that the large green table was his. I advised [redacted] that he could return to pick up these items once he arranged for transportation. [redacted] then left the area.

While taking photos of the different items that [redacted] had picked up I noticed that some of the boxed food items in the coolers had not even been opened. I found three different footballs throughout the pile of items and several pieces of clothing along with a large red Georgia "throw" blanket. These items along with the quality of several of the tent chairs led me to believe that the owners may return to claim their items after the game.

After I released [redacted] I spoke to several nearby tailgaters who stated that they saw [redacted] gathering the various items from different tailgates on the North Quad. They stated that the two large coolers and the large green folding table that [redacted] claimed were his were actually removed from tailgates by [redacted]. They stated that when they first saw [redacted] he did not have anything with him before he started collecting tailgate items. Consequently, I placed these three items back on the lawn of the North Quad so that the owners could see them when they returned.

At the time of this report no one had called to report any of their tailgating items missing. My flex camera was used for this incident.
