I was approached by [REDACTED] is an employee of Volstead. He stated there was a problem inside Volstead earlier with a male and they just got word that he was heading back with his fraternity friends to start trouble.

While he was telling me this, I heard people start yelling and people waving at officers for help. Officers went over and viewed the offender Quinton Beasley and a Volstead employee, [REDACTED] locked up with each other.

The two were separated as Beasley wouldn't let go of [REDACTED] arm and had to be pulled away.

I was approached next by the Volstead manager, [REDACTED] She stated that Beasley was in there earlier and had problems with one of her off duty employees. He was asked to leave and refused. When he was escorted out he took a swing at employees and stated he would come back with his fraternity brothers.

I spoke with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] is an employee of Volstead. He stated he was involved in escorting Beasley out the first time, so he recognized him as he walked back toward the bar. He stated Beasley tried to walk back in and grabbed a hold of him. [REDACTED] stated he kept him from getting in until officers arrived.

Beasley was placed into handcuffs (dl) searched and turned over to transport.

Beasley appeared to be very intoxicated.

[REDACTED] wanted Beasley barred from the bar. He was barred for two years. Beasley stated he understood.

On 10-19-2013 I was approaching the stop sign at Foundry St/ Oconee St. when I observed a black in color 2008 Nissan Sentra; [REDACTED], driven by Andrew Lucci, turning left onto Foundry St. from Oconee St. On Oconee St. there is a very clear and visible sign that indicates a no left turn onto Foundry St. from Oconee St. I turned around and initiated a traffic stop on that vehicle at the intersection of E Broad St/ Hickory St.

Upon approach of the vehicle I made contact with Lucci and asked to see his driver's license. I could immediately smell the very strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle and Lucci's eyes were red/ glossy. When I asked him where he was coming from, Lucci state that he was coming from Flannigan's bar. He then quickly changed his statement saying that he was coming from his girlfriend's place, whom apparently lives above Flannigan's bar. I then asked Lucci how much he had to drink tonight and he stated that he had a couple beers, specifically Bud Light, "just before that, that was earlier in the night." He then acknowledged making the illegal left turn. When I asked him when the last drink he had was, Lucci said about an hour ago and that he started drinking around 9:00pm. I then asked him if he had anything else to drink other than the two beers and he said, "nnnnnnno sir." It appeared to me that Lucci was pausing for a moment to consider how he was going to answer that question, when it was a straight forward yes or no question.

After running his OLN and finding out that Lucci's driver's license expired on 09-22-2013, I asked Lucci if he would step out of the vehicle and onto the sidewalk. When he stepped out of the vehicle I could smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person/ breath. I then asked Lucci to confirm with me that he only consumed two beers the entire night, first starting at 9:00pm and the last drink was approximately one hour before I initiated the traffic stop. I stopped Lucci at 4:19am. When I asked Lucci if that was correct, he said "no that's not correct." He then said, "technically I had two beers or so after 9:00pm but I stopped drinking at about 10:30pm." I then confronted Lucci on the fact that he had just previously told me that his last drink was about an hour prior to the stop, and he then hung his head, nodded up and down and said, "yes sir."

I then asked Lucci to be honest with me and tell me how much he had to drink tonight and Lucci said, "honestly I can't tell you how many I've had..I've definitely had, not had..5 I've had probably a few beers..that's honestly..a few beers up until an hour ago." I then asked him about the "5" number that he stated and Lucci then said three or four beers. I then asked Lucci if he would be willing to blow into my PBT, but Lucci said that he would rather do a blood test. I tried to explain to Lucci that he was not at the point of any state administered test, but again he said that he did not want to blow into the PBT.

Lucci then said that he would love to just walk home because he lived right around the corner. He also asked if he could contact his lawyer. He continued saying that he wanted a blood test while I was trying to explain to him the PBT. Eventually Lucci refused to blow into the PBT.

At this point I asked him to do SFST and Lucci agreed. The following are the instructions read and the results of SFST for Lucci:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

- 1.I am going to check your eyes.
- 2.(Are you wearing any contacts?) Keep your head still and follow this stimulus with your eyes only.
- 3.Do not move your head.
- 4.Do you understand the instructions?

Results:

- xLack of smooth pursuit: Left eye
- xLack of smooth pursuit: Right eye
- xDistinct and sustained nystagmus maximum deviation: Left eye
- xDistinct and sustained nystagmus maximum deviation: Right eye
- xOnset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees: Left eye
- xOnset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees: Right eye

Walk and Turn:

- 1.Put your left foot on the line and then your right foot in front of it with your right heel touching your left toe. Keep your hands at your side. (Demonstrate)
- 2.Do not walk until I tell you to.
- 3.Do you understand?
- 4.When I tell you to begin, take 9 heel-to-toe steps.
- 5.When you turn, keep your front foot on the line and turn taking a series of small steps with the other foot. (At this time I demonstrated to Lucci the instructions up until this point)
- 6.Keep your arms at your sides at all times, watch your feet, and count each step out loud. Do not stop until you have completed the test.
- 7.Do you understand the instructions?
- 8.You may begin.

4. Do you understand the instructions?
5. You may begin the test.

Based upon my observations of Lucci's driving; the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle, his person and breath; the admission of having consumed at least 5 beers after having admittedly lied to me about how much he had actually consumed; red/ glossy eyes; Lucci asking I would just let him go and allow him to walk home; his admitted feeling of needing to talk to his lawyer and the number of clues (10) present during SFST, I placed Lucci under arrest for DUI.

As I was placing handcuffs on him, Lucci said he did not understand why I was arresting him because I had not yet given him a blood test. He repeated the fact that I did not test him multiple times and again said that he wanted to talk to his lawyer. I then walked Lucci to my patrol vehicle and began searching him and while searching him, Lucci asked once again if I would just let him walk home. After searching, I immediately read him Implied Consent for Suspects Age 21 or Over. After reading Implied Consent, Lucci wanted to ask me multiple questions. I told Lucci that I was not able to explain

anything to him. I then re-read Implied Consent to Lucci. I again read for the state's breath test and Lucci again asked to walk home and talk to his lawyer. He then asked me if I would drive him home. After asking one final time if he would consent to the state's breath test, and Lucci saying that he needed to think about it, I took his stalling/ indecision as a refusal.

I then asked the other passengers in the vehicle if they were sober enough to drive the vehicle home so that I would not have to tow it, but they all told me that they were too drunk to drive. I told central to send a NIL.

After Barrett's towed the vehicle, I transported Lucci to the jail where I turned him over to the custody of CCSO. Lucci was issued a citation for DUI, Improper Left Turn and Driving with and Expired License.

On 10-19-2013 I was traveling north bound on N Milledge Ave. when I observed a silver in color 2007 Mitsubishi Galant; [REDACTED], driven by Nathan Foley, with an inoperable left brake light. I initiated a traffic stop on Foley at the intersection of Prince Ave/ Lyndon Ave.

Upon approach of the vehicle I made contact with Foley and could immediately smell the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle. I asked Foley where he was coming from and he told me that he had just dropped some friends off and that he was headed back to his place. I then asked him how much he had to drink and Foley told me that he had one or two PBR beers. Foley also said that his last drink was about a half an hour prior to the stop and that he started drinking an hour or two before that.

After running his driver's license information I asked Foley to exit the vehicle and then asked if he would be willing to blow into my PBT. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person/ breathe. Foley told me that he would prefer not to blow into my PBT and when I asked him why, Foley stated that he believed that he was under the legal limit, but he was afraid that if he blew, the PBT results would indicate that he was above the legal limit. Foley tried to ask me on a couple of different occasion if I would just let him walk home. He also stated that "I cannot get in trouble for this for Vet School." Just for confirmation, I asked Foley once again if he would blow into my PBT and he refused saying that he was not 100% sure that he was ok to be driving.

I then asked Foley if he would be willing to do SFST and he agreed. We walked to a parking lot that was straight and level and had straight white lines on them. The following are the instructions read and the results of SFST for Foley:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus:

- 1.I am going to check your eyes.
- 2.(Are you wearing any contacts?) Keep your head still and follow this stimulus with your eyes only.
- 3.Do not move your head.
- 4.Do you understand the instructions?

Based upon my observations: the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from inside the vehicle, his person and breath; the admission of having just consumed two beers within the last hour or so; the fact that Foley himself told me that he was not completely sure that he was ok to be driving; he stated that he thought he might be ok to drive but refused to blow into my PBT because he was worried that the result would indicate that he was above the legal limit; swaying during HGN and the glossy eyes; the number of clues (12) present during SFST, I placed Foley under arrest for DUI.

I then walked him back to my patrol vehicle where I searched his person and then immediately read him Implied Consent for Suspects Age 21 or Over. Foley refused that state's breath test. 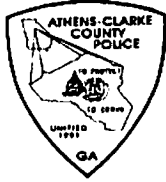

NARRATIVE

On 10-19-2013 at approx. 1237 hours I met with [REDACTED] in reference to a sexual battery that had occurred about a month ago involving an [REDACTED]. She told me that on September 16th between 1500 and 1600 hours (when the suspect's daughter arrives home) she was over at [REDACTED] house to help him do some things. She said that at one point, when they were sitting on the couch watching TV she got up and went to use the bath room. She said that when she came out of the bath room he was there and attacked her. She told me that he ripped off her clothing and raped her. She said that when it was over she left as quickly as she could and went home. She said that she didn't report the assault immediately because she was scared of [REDACTED] and because she has been raped before. She told me that she has called 2 times since the incident to report it to officers but she didn't think a report was made. I had communications check and [REDACTED] has called 2 other times from her residence. The first, on 10-07-13, she was reporting harassing phone calls from [REDACTED] and did say that he had touched her but she also told them that she didn't want a report made. The other call was on 10-09-13, when she was reporting that [REDACTED] was at the [REDACTED] and she thought that he was already barred from the complex. It does not appear that on either of the calls did [REDACTED] tell communications or the officers what had actually occurred at [REDACTED].

While I spoke to [REDACTED] she appeared nervous, jumpy and looked around a lot. She also told me that her mother knows of the incident and her mother told her that [REDACTED] will come back around her. She said that 2 days later he had been in the area of [REDACTED] picking up items and that's when she had called the 2nd time.

I asked her about her clothing that she had on the day of the rape and she told me that she still has the under wear at her apartment and they have not been washed. I retrieved a paper evidence bag from my patrol vehicle and gloved up then went to [REDACTED]. She went to her bedroom and brought back a dirty pair of women's white underwear. I had her drop them in the paper evidence bag the closed the bag. I later entered them into uniform evidence locker U-2.

I provided a card with the case number and some paper work with phone numbers for [REDACTED] to call to set up some counseling for the traumatic incident. I also explained that a detective will be calling and following up with her and the next time that she sees [REDACTED] in the area for her to call police and see if the management of [REDACTED] will agree to give [REDACTED] criminal trespass warning from the complex.

As I was talking with Ms. Mouvery I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from her breath. I also noticed that she had very watery and light blood shot eyes and slurred speech. I asked Ms. Mouvery how much she had to drink. She stated that she had one beer and that was all. Ms. Mouvery agreed to take some field sobriety tests to make sure she was alright to drive. As Ms. Mouvery got out of the vehicle she dropped a quarter on the ground. I told her she could pick it up. As Ms. Mouvery bent over she almost fell over I put my arm out so she would not fall. Ms. Mouvery had on some high heeled shoes. I had her take the shoes off so she could perform the tests without heels. We then began the tests.

I placed Ms. Mouvery under arrest for DUI. Ms. Mouvery was placed in the back of my patrol car where I read her the Georgia implied consent for person over the age of 21yrs old. Ms. Mouvery agreed to take the State's blood test. While searching incident to the arrest when I open the drivers side door and a beer glass came rolling out of the car that was between the door and the seat and broke on the ground. The glass was dry and there was no beer inside the glass. Ms. Mouvery was transported to ARMC for the test. As we got to ARMC and were waiting for a female Nurse or security guards Ms. Mouvery urinated on herself. After the blood test Ms. Mouvery was transported to the Clarke County jail and was issued two citations. The incident was recorded on the vehicle's camera system.
