Notes/Narratives

NARRATIVE

This date this officer responded to Chick Piano, 240 West Clayton Street in reference to meeting with [REDACTED] about a saxophone that had been brought in. Made contact with [REDACTED] and he indicated that a black male brought a saxophone into the store wanting to sell it. What made [REDACTED] suspicious was that the offender indicated that he used the saxophone when he was in the middle school band. [REDACTED] knew by looking at the saxophone that it was an expensive instrument. Also on the front of the case was a partially removed sticker with what appeared to show High School in Hartwell, GA. The serial number and model number was also on this sticker. Also was a sticker that had a name on it. The first name had been written over but the last name showed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was the victim in [REDACTED]. Shepherd indicated that in the back of his mind he remembered a male coming by giving a description of a saxophone to what was similar to the one that was brought in. That saxophone had been stolen in an entering auto case. [REDACTED] told the young man that he would have to look up some items on the saxophone and if he would leave his name and number he would give him a call back sometime after 1400 hours. The male left his name which was Reggie Battle and a number of [REDACTED].

Took down the saxophone information and came back to the station and verified that it was the stolen saxophone from [REDACTED]. Contact was made with Detective Doug Wyatt so that we could have a plain clothes officer inside the store and myself and Sgt. Scott outside in the area for when Battle returned. Officers observed a 1992 Acura Legend, [REDACTED], pull up and park and a black male exited and went into Chick Piano. Officers made contact with Battle and placed him under arrest for Theft By Receiving Stolen Property.

Offender was transported to the Downtown Station for Detective Wyatt to interview. After the interview the offender was transported to the Clarke County Jail. A friend of the offender was contacted to come and pick up his vehicle which was parked on West Clayton Street. Pictures were taken of the saxophone and attached to the report. Contacted the victim for him to come and pick his property up at the station.
