**NARRATIVE**

On 03-03-2014 I was riding a two man unit with Ofc. Phillips and we were traveling southeast bound on Oak St. when we observed a white in color 1998 GMC Sierra, tag: BKJ 5587, driven by Sammy Beasley Jr. traveling in the opposite direction with only one operating head light.

We turned around and observed Beasley taking a right turn on to S. Poplar St. We also made a right turn on to S Poplar St. and began to follow Beasley as he made a left turn on Mulberry St. Beasley then made a left turn on to E Broad St. at which point we decided to initiate a traffic stop on Beasley with the hope that he would pull into the Greenway parking lot. After initiating the emergency blue lights, Beasley began to slow down, and it appeared as though he was going to turn into the Greenway. However, Beasley did not make the turn, but instead proceeded north on E Broad St.

At this time I called out over the radio that we were attempting to make a traffic stop on Beasley, as he proceeded through the intersection of E Broad/ First St. and that it was clear that Beasley was fleeing and attempting to elude, as our lights and sirens were activated. During this time, Beasley was failing to maintain his lanes, when his left tires crossed over the double lines. While Ofc. Phillips was driving, I was giving out our radio traffic as to direction of travel and speeds to other responding units. As Beasley made a right turn on to Third St. from MLK Pkwy, I observed the driver's side door of Beasley's vehicle open, as he was still driving. Based upon my knowledge training and experience I knew that Beasley was looking for a place to ditch his vehicle and begin to run on foot.

Beasley then failed to stop at a stop sign as he made a right turn on to Pearl St. and immediately slammed his vehicle in park and bailed out of the vehicle and began to run on foot. I immediately exited our patrol vehicle and began to pursue on foot, giving Beasley verbal commands to stop running and to get on the ground. However, Beasley ignored my verbal commands and continued to run. Just as Beasley was approaching Pearl St/ Second St. he lost his balance running and fell to the ground. As I was right behind Beasley, as soon as he hit the ground, I jumped on top of his back. Beasley immediately attempted to get back up and tried to push me off of himself.

I was able to push him back down to the ground, but Beasley was actively fighting/ resisting my verbal commands and soft/ open hand tactics. At this point Ofc. Phillips arrived and assisted as we fought with Beasley to get him on the ground. Beasley continued to resist, refusing to give up his arms upon command. I delivered several open hand strikes to the body and head of Beasley, which seemed to be minimally effective at best, as he continued fighting/ resisting. At one point, I felt and observed Beasley take his right arm/ hand and reach for my belt, but he was unable to grab anything. As Ofc. Phillips

was trying to restrain Beasley, I was able to grab his right arm and get handcuffs on his right wrist. We continued to give verbal commands to Beasley to give us his other hand, but he refused and continued to actively fight/ resist. Eventually, Ofc. Phillips was able to get Beasley's left arm out from underneath his person, at which point I grabbed his left wrist and attempted to place handcuffs on that wrist, but Beasley continued actively resisting.

At this point, other responding officers showed up on scene and with the use of a second pair of handcuffs, we were able to get Beasley secured in handcuffs. We then stood Beasley up and walked him to Ofc. Blair's patrol vehicle, where he was searched and then placed in the back seat.

I then began to search the area from Beasley's vehicle to where he was he was apprehended, and directly next to where we fought with him and eventually placed him into custody, I found a clear plastic bag with a white powdery substance in it. That white powder was later field tested positive for Cocaine.

While I sat with the vehicle, Ofc. Blair and SPO Carroll transported Beasley to the jail where he was turned over to the custody of CCSO. Beasley was charged with Possession of Cocaine, Felony Obstruction, Fleeing and Attempting to Elude, Failure to Maintain Lanes, Stop Sign Violation and Head Lights Required.

During the course of our struggle with Beasley, I incurred what appeared to be some minor cuts/ abrasions on my hands, wrist, elbows and knees. Ofc. Phillips also injured his hand and had to go to the hospital for further medical treatment.

This incident was recorded on the Arbitrator system of vehicle 227. Pictures and audio will be attached.
