**NARRATIVE**

On the listed dates and times I was patrolling the area of Fowler Dr. I observed a vehicle in front of me traveling west bound stopped in the roadway. It initially appeared as though the vehicle was stopping for the stop sign at Fowler Dr. and Freeman Dr. I then saw the reverse lights come on and the vehicle began backing up, after a short distance they stopped again and pulled into the driveway of 320 Fowler Dr. As I drove past the vehicle I could only see what appeared to be two people, the driver and a front seat passenger. I ran the tag on the vehicle PDX8116 and saw that it returned to an address off of Brookstone Dr. The vehicle turned its lights off and sat in the driveway and I did not see anyone get out. I decided to drive down the road a little and turn around to give the occupants time to exit the vehicle. As I drove back up to the intersection of Freeman Dr. and Fowler Dr. I could still see two people sitting in the vehicle and the lights were still off. I decided to make contact with them and find out what they were doing and if they belonged there.

When I exited my patrol car I could see the driver immediately lean to her right and was reaching/digging for something. I quickly approached the vehicle from the passenger side and could see the driver later identified as Ashley Brooks shoving something in her purse. I gave her verbal commands to stop messing with her purse and she continued to mess with her purse. I again gave her verbal commands to stop messing with her purse and she finally stopped doing whatever she was doing and zipped her purse up. I told her to place her hands on the steering wheel where I could see them and to leave them there. While I was waiting on another Officer to come up to the vehicle I asked the two females in the car if they lived at the house and if not what they were doing there. The driver told me that they just brought a male over here to pick up his brother. Another Officer on scene stood by while I walked back to my patrol car and started my in car video.

I made contact with Ms. Brooks and asked her if I was going to find anything illegal in her purse or the car. She said I would not find anything in the car and that I could search the car. I asked her again if there was anything in her purse and she told me no, but that she had some cigarettes. She then told me the reason she was reaching in her purse was to get her wallet however she did not have her wallet in her hand at any point and it never appeared to me that she was attempting to get her wallet out. When I grabbed her purse I immediately noticed that it was not zipped up even though I saw her pull a zipper. I also noticed that her wallet was lying on top of everything in her purse and that it would have been easily accessible if she was attempting to grab it like she said she was. Inside of the purse I noticed another zipper to a smaller pocket. When I unzipped the pocket I observed a pipe which I thought was used for smoking methamphetamine. I asked Ms. Brooks what type of drugs she used and she told me that she occasionally uses methamphetamine. I asked if that's what she used the pipe for and she said yes. I asked if she was at the house to buy drugs and she stated she wasn't. She told me she was just giving someone a ride. I noticed that the only thing in her wallet was an ID card and some cash and in

the pocket with the cash was a small orange zip lock bag containing a small amount of crystal like substance. Ms. Brooks told me that the substance in the bag was in fact methamphetamine.

While I was initially talking to Ms. Brooks the resident of [REDACTED] came outside to see what was happening and told me that she did not know the female in the car. She did confirm the story about a male just getting dropped off and she told me he was inside.

I identified the passenger as [REDACTED] I asked Ms. Davis what they were doing and she gave me the same story as her mother. She said they gave a male a ride from a friend's house and that they stopped to get gas and then brought him here (320 Fowler Dr.) I placed Ms. Davis in the back of my vehicle.

When other Officers arrived on scene I also sat Ms. Brooks in the back of the vehicle while we conducted a search of the vehicle. Officer Hudson found a pink spoon with a little bit of white residue on it under the driver's seat. I located a small purple bag in the backseat underneath some trash and another bag. Inside of the purple bag was another spoon, a needle and some q-tips. All of the items were collected and placed in my patrol car.

I made contact with the male who identified himself as the guy who got the ride from Ms. Brooks. He was identified as [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] told me that she did give him a ride. He said they gave him a ride, they stopped by the gas station and he put a little gas in the car. He said after they dropped him off they were supposed to leave. I explained to him what Ms. Brooks told me and asked if that was the deal and he said no "they were supposed to drop him off and get the hell on". He said he did not know the residents at the house but that his brother did.

I went back to my patrol vehicle and was going to field test the substance in the orange bag and realized that there was not much in the bag and that it would be better to preserve the evidence and have it sent off for testing by the GBI. Photos were taken of all the evidence and placed in the trunk of my patrol vehicle. All of the items will be placed into evidence.

Ms. Brooks was placed under arrest for possession of methamphetamines and possession of drug related objects. She was transported to the Clarke County Jail where she was released into the custody of CCSO Deputies.

The vehicle was left on scene at her request.

Ms. Davis was given a ride home by other Officers on scene.

The entire incident was recorded by my Arbitrator in car camera system.
