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Notes/Narratives

NARRATIVE

On 08/29/13 at 2048 hours I was dispatched to Rogers Road Family Housing Building N in reference to a report of a suspicious person. I was advised by dispatch that the person was going through the buildings asking for money. Dispatch advised the suspicious person was wearing a white t-shirt with khaki pants. Upon arrival I encountered a male matching the description at the bus stop located in front of Building P. Upon making contact I recognized the resident assistant for the area standing in the back ground. I identified the male as [REDACTED] and asked him what he was doing in the area and if he lived in family housing. [REDACTED] advised he was visiting a friend but could not tell me the apartment number only the building. [REDACTED] stated his friend lived in Building N. Officer Storey arrived and stood by with [REDACTED] while I went and spoke with the resident assistant. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised he had called and that he had witnessed [REDACTED] around vehicles in the parking lot located in front of Building N. [REDACTED] stated he witnessed [REDACTED] glancing in to vehicles casually. [REDACTED] was able to point out three vehicles that were parked close together and stated they were the vehicles he viewed [REDACTED] looking in. [REDACTED] stated once he exited his vehicle [REDACTED] went into the stairwell of Building M and was asking residents for money. I then went and examined the vehicles to see if there were any signs of forced entry or if they appeared to have been gone through. I could not see that any of the vehicles had been entered. I then returned to where Officer Storey was with [REDACTED] and asked Officer Storey what had been said.

Officer Storey stated he gave the same story he gave me but gave a name for the person he was visiting. Officer Storey stated [REDACTED] could only give the first name of the friend. Officer Storey also stated he asked him about his criminal involvement. Officer Storey stated [REDACTED] said he only had priors for marijuana. We then confronted [REDACTED] about his criminal involvement because we knew through I-Leads he had priors for entering auto. [REDACTED] then came clean about his criminal involvements and stated he was not trying to break into cars. The decision was made to bar [REDACTED] from all of University of Georgia Family Housing for 90 days for loitering and prowling. The time frame and barring was set by Lieutenant Fouche. [REDACTED] was released with his copy of the barring notice and got on a bus and left the area. [REDACTED] was then asked if he would give a written statement. [REDACTED] stated he would and filled out a witness statement.

The incident was recorded on vehicle 95135's MVR.

On August 30, 2013 I responded to [REDACTED] in regards to a burglary.

I met with [REDACTED] She advised that she had arrived at her home, at 11:09 pm, and unlocked her front door. She went upstairs to her room and saw that her television was missing. She went down stairs and saw that the back door was standing wide open. The door had been forced open.

[REDACTED] arrived on scene and advised that she left the house at eight pm. After she left, there were no other cars parked around her house.

Drawers had been pulled open in every room. A TV was stolen from the living room. In an upstairs bedroom another television was taken. In a separate upstairs bedroom a computer, an ipod, and a television were taken.

The house was dusted for prints. None were able to be lifted. Shoeprints were also unattainable.

There was a window with cracked glass on the rear, right side of the house. The residents were unsure if the window was cracked before this incident.
