

### Maine Outbreak Analysis

#### **Outbreak Numbers**

- Cases connected to August 7 Millinocket wedding: At least 180
- Connected deaths: 8
- Sanford, pop. 22,000, makes up 44% of Maine's new cases

#### **Risk Factors Identified by Maine CDC**


- Lack of social distancing and mask wearing by individuals
- Institutional failures in following guidelines and regulations
- Complacency



#### **Outbreak Summary**

- Cases to date: 87
  - 18 towns & 4 counties (Washington,
     Chittenden, Orange, Windsor) impacted
  - Continued spread led to 4 additional outbreaks including at least 41 cases identified at St. Michael's College
  - Led to exposure at 19 locations including worksites and schools
- Total contacts to date: 473

#### Running total: 2

- Initial 2 cases reported in central Vermont
- Both cases associated with sports leagues
- Central Vermont Memorial Civic
   Center closed for cleaning

#### **Initial Cases Reported to VDH**




#### Additional Spread Reported: October 12, 2020 (18 days ago)




## Cases Reported at Saint Michael's: October 18, 2020 (12 days ago)

#### Running total: 30

- 8 initial cases detected on campus through surveillance testing
- Contact tracing conducted as COVID-positive individuals go into quarantine
- First report of transmission on campus on October 21, 2020 (9 days ago)
- St. Michael's announces it will test all students and move to remote classes
- 6 additional cases yesterday


#### St. Michael's Outbreak






## Outbreak Summary October 30, 2020 (today)



- Gatherings of unmasked individuals
- Individuals not in quarantine:
  - After being identified as a close contact
  - Upon return from a red travel zone
  - Despite having COVID-like symptoms
- Conducting daily community activities despite
   COVID tests pending
- Symptomatic people denying symptoms during health screenings
