

Shared Use Path along Randolph Road in Hopewell

Find out about the proposed project to convert the sidewalk on the south side of Randolph Road, extending from North 6th Avenue to North Main Street, to a shared use path for pedestrians and bicyclist.

The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. This format will provide the flexibility to allow participants to meet and discuss the proposed project directly with project staff members.

Review the project plans regarding the proposed modification and the draft National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) documentation at the public hearing or at VDOT's Richmond District Office located at 2430 Pine Forest Drive, South Chesterfield, VA 23834-9002, 804-524-6000, 1-800-367-7623 or TTY/TDD 711. In compliance with NEPA CFR Part 771 and the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed or eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places are included in the NEPA documentation. Pursuant to the requirements of 23 CFR 774.5, notice is hereby given that VDOT is accepting written comments regarding the Virginia Department of Historic Resources' preliminary concurrence with the Federal Highway Administration's Section 4(f) applicability criteria for de minimis impacts on the B Village Historic District (VDHR ID 116-5032), Downtown Hopewell Historic District (VDHR ID 116-5031), and Hopewell Municipal Building (VDHR ID 116-5001), as a result of project UPC 122203 Randolph Road Sidewalk Improvements. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions. Property impact information and tentative construction schedules are available for your review at the above addresses and will be available at the public hearing. As the project's design is developed and finalized, VDOT will determine the location of the right of way and/or easements that will be needed to accommodate construction of the project and future maintenance. The property owners that are affected by right of way acquisitions will be notified of the proposed location of the right of way and/or easements needed during the right of way acquisition process and prior to construction of the project. Right of Way acquisition will be performed in accordance with the Federal Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act and all applicable federal and state laws, and VDOT policies and standards.
