The new design will feature curb and gutter, a raised concrete central island, and splitter islands at each approach to help slow vehicles and guide traffic. Roundabouts are proven to reduce severe crashes compared to traditional intersections by lowering speeds and eliminating conflict points, making this project an investment in safety and reliability for the New Kent community.

The meeting will be held in an open house format from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. This format will provide the flexibility to allow participants to meet and discuss the proposed project directly with project staff members.
