- Performs interdepartmental personnel functions in cooperation with the Director of Safety & Human Resources (e.g. hiring, promoting, terminating and, evaluating, supervising, counseling, disciplining, directing, training, etc.) for the purpose of maintaining adequate staffing, enhancing productivity of personnel and achieving objectives within budget.
