Growing up in Virginia, Joe Jamison witnessed firsthand how the world wasn't built with everyone in mind. His father, who has paraplegia and uses a wheelchair, was often treated differently from the rest of the family. Those experiences left a lasting impression—and ultimately inspired a lifelong mission.

In 2019, while studying at the University of Virginia and pursuing a minor in Entrepreneurship, Jamison was tasked with creating a capstone project. His idea was personal and powerful: find a way to help his father—and others facing similar challenges—feel seen, respected, and included. That idea became **VisitAble**, a company working to create more welcoming and accessible experiences for all

Today, as Founder and CEO, Jamison leads VisitAble in partnering with organizations, institutions, and communities across the country to advance disability inclusion. VisitAble serves as a bridge between the disability community and the broader public, helping companies and agencies better understand, accommodate, and empower people of all abilities.

"Our mission is to change the way the world views disability," Jamison said. "Accessibility isn't just about physical spaces—it's about attitudes, awareness, and connection."

When he's not leading VisitAble, Jamison can often be found on the court, playing wheelchair basketball court with the

Charlottesville Cardinals or sharing his love of music through the **cello and piano**.
