

Public Hearing on Community Development Needs and Program Performance and Notice of Availability of Funds

Henrico County, Virginia

As a participant in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), Henrico County will prepare an Annual Action Plan for submission to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The 2026-27 Annual Action Plan will include the County's proposed uses of CDBG and HOME funds for the program year beginning October 1, 2026, through September 30, 2027.

Henrico County will conduct a public hearing at 6:00 pm, Wednesday, February 11, 2026, at the Fairfield Area Library, 1401 Laburnum Ave., Henrico, VA 23223. The public hearing provides the public with an opportunity to express opinions on community development needs in Henrico County and past performance of community development programs as reported in the 2024-25 CAPER. The County encourages all residents to attend, especially those who are low- and moderate-income or reside in low- and moderate-income communities, to share their opinions about community development needs in the County. Needs may include housing, enhancement of neighborhoods, expansion of economic opportunities, or any other community needs that residents consider important.
