The Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), in partnership with the Town of Kilmarnock, Lancaster County and the Northern Neck Planning District Commission, is holding a public information meeting to share potential improvements proposed by two transportation studies underway in Lancaster County.

The purpose of both studies is to develop concepts for future funding applications. Draft concepts for potential future projects are now being presented for public comment before the study reports are finalized. These studies do not propose timelines for construction for any potential future improvements.

One study evaluated Route 3 between Hawthorne Avenue and School Street in the Town of Kilmarnock. A second, separate study evaluated Route 200 between Old Saint Johns Road to Harris Road, southwest of the Kilmarnock town limits.

Both studies are part of VDOT's Strategically Targeted Affordable Roadway Solutions (STARS) program.

Stop by the meeting between 5-7 p.m. to review study materials and conceptual design displays. The meeting will be held in an open house format. Staff will be available to answer questions.
