

Route 33 and Route 14 Intersection Improvements King and Queen County Notice of Willingness www.vdot.virginia.gov/Rt33andRt14

Find out about a proposed plan to improve safety at the Route 33 (Lewis B. Puller Memorial Highway) and Route 14 (Buena Vista Road) intersection in King and Queen County.

The proposed project will offset and extend the right turn lane on Route 33 eastbound to increase capacity and provide better sight distance for travelers. The proposed project will also add an intersection conflict warning system (ICWS), which includes signs and flashing amber lights, to alert drivers on Route 33 of vehicles entering the intersection from Route 14.

Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate staff to answer your questions. The National Environmental Policy Act documentation will be in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to the attention of Isabel Kigo, P.E., VDOT Project Manager at 12600 Fair Lakes Circle, Suite 300, Fairfax, VA 22033. The request must be postmarked on or prior to Sept. 22, 2025. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will be provided in the environmental documentation.
