**Find out** about a proposed plan to replace a culvert on Route 637 (Hustle Road) over Blackwater Swamp in Essex County.

The proposed project will replace the existing culvert with a concrete box culvert, replace the riprap and upgrade guardrails. The proposed work will close the road with nearly a 3.5-mile detour for approximately four months.

The National Environmental Policy Act documentation will be in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to the attention of Elyas Jalalzai, VDOT Project Manager, at 87 Deacon Road, Fredericksburg, VA 22405. The request must be postmarked on or prior to **January 22, 2026**. If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.

In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed project on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will be provided in the environmental documentation.
