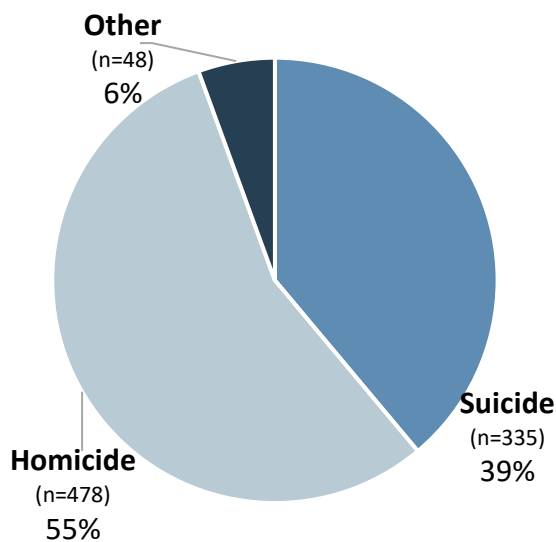




CHILD AND TEEN FIREARM DEATHS IN VIRGINIA

- From 2012 to 2021 in Virginia:
 - The child and teen firearm death rate doubled over the last decade.
 - 861 children ages 0-19 died from gun violence. One-half of child and teen firearm deaths (55%) were homicides.
 - 85% of child and teen firearm deaths were between the ages of 15-19 years and 84% were among males.
 - 73% of child and teen firearm homicide deaths were among Black people while 82% of child and teen firearm suicide deaths were among white people.

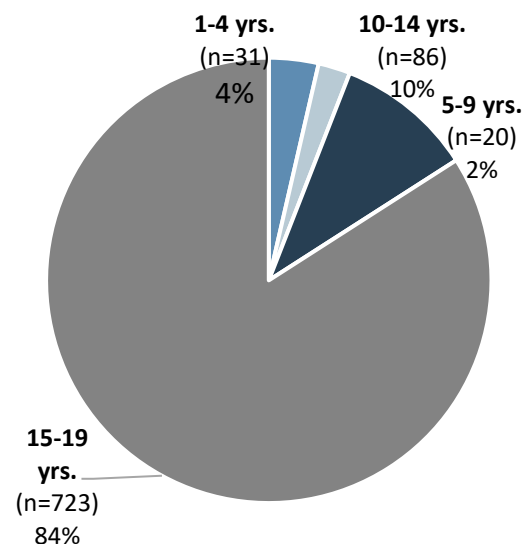

Total Gun Deaths in 2012-2021: 861

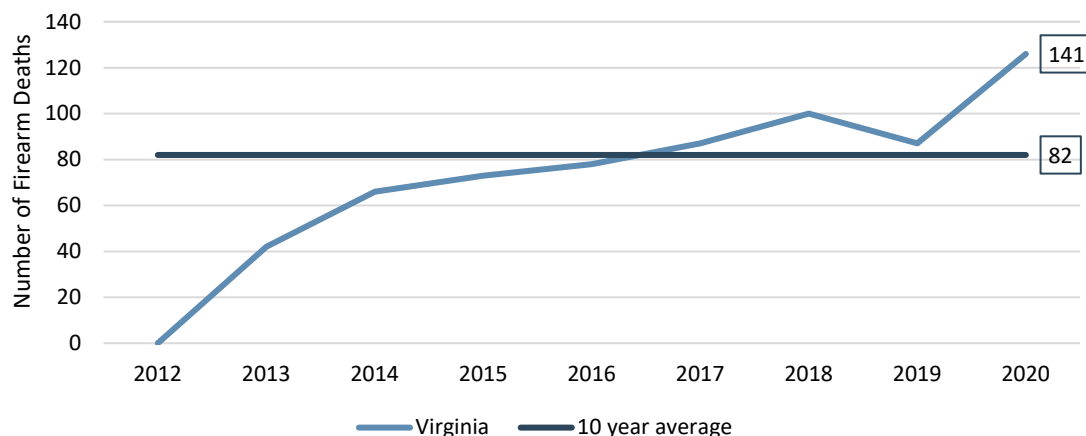

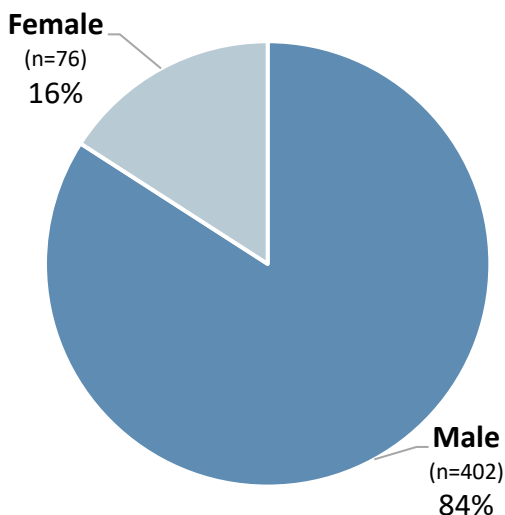

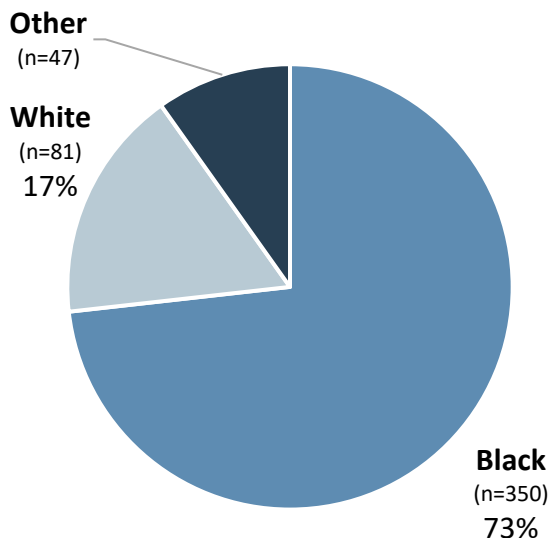

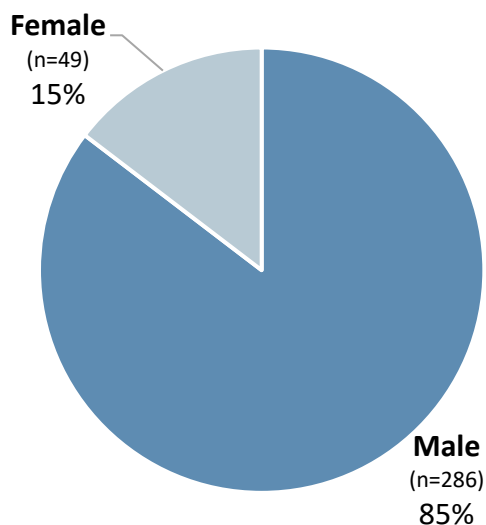
CHILD AND TEEN FIREARM HOMICIDE DEATHS IN VIRGINIA BY SEX, 2012-2021



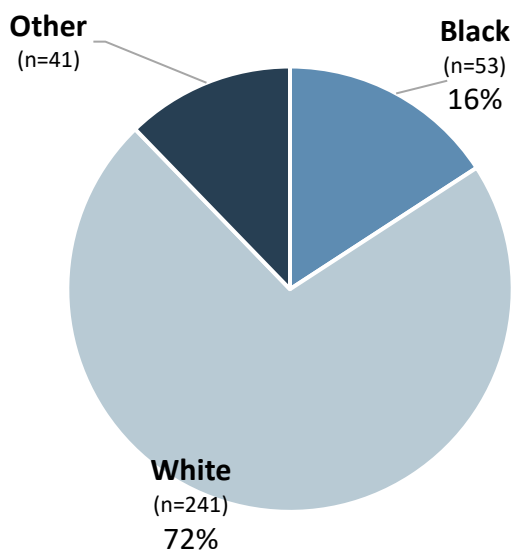
CHILD AND TEEN FIREARM HOMICIDE DEATHS IN VIRGINIA BY RACE, 2012-2021
