

# Transportation construction underway in Chesterfield County

Chesterfield County has three major roads projects in the works.

## Midlothian Turnpike between Chippenham and State Route 288

Midlothian Turnpike has long been a major route serving several shopping centers; but as developers take their ideas for ways to bring new life to these to county planners, the planners now are turning attention to addressing traffic and pedestrian needs that those new ideas bring.

## Powwhite Parkway extension

Building an extension of the Powwhite Parkway to link it to Hull Street Road (U.S. 360) would take it through the woods of the undeveloped Upper Magnolia Green Tract, where Chesterfield hopes to build its next major technology park, aiming to bring thousands of jobs and multi-millions of new investment and tax revenue.

## State Route 10 between U.S. 1 and I-295

Chesterfield made improvements here a priority in 1992 because of traffic slowdowns and jams on this artery through a fast-developing part of the county. The final piece, a new-style “super-street” intersection at Meadowville Road (State Route 618) which gives access to Meadowville Technology Park, where Lego is building its first U.S. plant, should be completed later this year.
