GETTING THERE

Free parking and shuttles are available from City Stadium at 3201 Maplewood Ave. Shuttle stops are on Second Street at Spring Street and Seventh Street at Byrd Street. Car travel is generally not allowed south of Canal Street in the festival area. Downtown parking is available on the street or in parking lots/garages charging \$5 to \$10. Handicapped parking is in the Federal Reserve deck at Fifth and Byrd streets. ADA shuttles will operate on Fifth Street. Bike parking is near Second and Byrd streets. Bring a bike lock.
