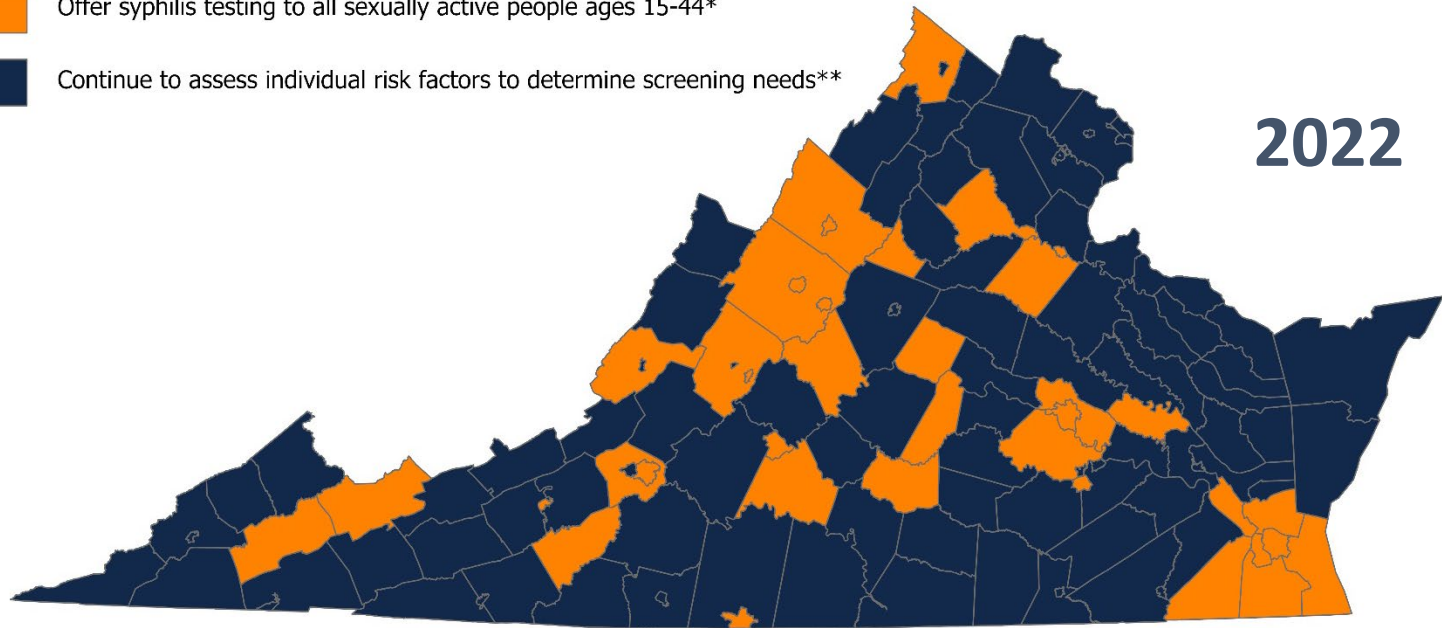


Virginia Syphilis Screening Guidelines by County/City

- Offer syphilis testing to all sexually active people ages 15-44*
- Continue to assess individual risk factors to determine screening needs**

* In counties with a rate of primary & secondary syphilis among women aged 15-44 years greater than 4.6 per 100,000 in 2022, providers should offer syphilis testing to all sexually active people aged 15-44 years.

** In counties with a rate of primary & secondary syphilis among women aged 15-44 years less than or equal to 4.6 per 100,000 in 2022, providers should continue to assess individual risk factors to determine screening needs as outlined in existing [screening guidelines](#).
