

Grocery wars

Total grocery sales in the Richmond region for the 12 months that ended March 31 was \$4.1 billion, up from \$3.443 billion in the previous 12 months. The survey included sales in Richmond and the counties of Henrico, Chesterfield, Hanover, Goochland, New Kent, Charles City, Dinwiddie and Powhatan. The 2019-20 figures have been revised.
