

Route 772 (Sinking Creek Road) Bridge Replacement Giles County

Find out about a project to replace the Route 772 (Sinking Creek Road) bridge over Sinking Creek in Giles County. The project entails replacing the aging existing bridge with a modern structure that meets current standards. The bridge is located 2.30 miles from Route 771 (Lebanon Road) and ends 0.45 mile from Route 612 (Eggleston Road). During construction, a detour will be in place for approximately 12 to 14 months.

Review the project information and National Environmental Policy Act document in the form of a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion at VDOT's Salem District Office located at 731 Harrison Avenue in Salem, 540-387-5353 1-800-FOR-ROAD, or TTY/TDD 711. Please call ahead to ensure the availability of appropriate personnel to answer your questions.

If your concerns cannot be satisfied, VDOT is willing to hold a public hearing. You may request that a public hearing be held by sending a written request to Edward Cake, Virginia Department of Transportation, 731 Harrison Avenue, Salem, VA 24153 on or prior to **November 20, 2025**.

If a request for a public hearing is received, notice of date, time and place of the hearing will be posted.
